And on March 13, 2024, at about 6.00 PM, when me and other 15-20 relatives and friends were silently and peacefully praying in a closed door room, about 15 miscreants suddenly came and trespassed in that house, abused and threatened us, and Domjur Police came there, and instead of arresting those wrongdoer miscreants, police took with them, 3 persons among us, namely 1) Asit Bag, 2) Raju Pal, 3) Krisna Jana, at Domjur PS, and sat them at about 6.30 PM to 11.00 PM without any cogent reason, thereafter they released them and told us not to make any praying program in that area, and if 15-20 persons want to gather and pray

peacefully, they should have gotten prior permission from them. Though our constitution says that any person has the full right to practice any religion,

- 4) That in reply to the said R.T.I. application, the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Head Quarters & SPIO, had replied on 25/04/24 to the appellant through O/C Domjur PS, a copy which depicts neither the answer to the appellant's queries nor any specific answer to my said application.


The Reply Copy of the said R.T.I. application is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure "P2".

- 5) That the appellant state and submits that is the bounded duty of the SPIO, under the law to answer to the specific questions made by the applicant by invoking the provisions of the R.T.I. Act as the questions which are asked all are public in nature.
