There is no record in this public authority to show that Insp. Tirthankar Dey , O.C. - (v) **Section 8 of the Right to Information Act, 2005** deals with the Exemption from disclosure of information. **Section 8(1)(j)** of the RTI Act states that information which relates to personal information the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interest, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual unless the Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer or the appellate authority, as the case may be, is satisfied that the larger public interest justifies the disclosure of such information: Provided that the **information which cannot be denied to the Parliament or a State Legislature shall not be denied to any person.** Section 8(2) Notwithstanding anything in the Official Secrets Act, 1923 (19 of 1923) nor any of the exemptions permissible in accordance with the relevant sub-section), a public authority may allow access to information, if public interest in disclosure outweighs the harm to the protected interests.

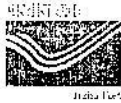

windscreen of the vehicle he had travelled.

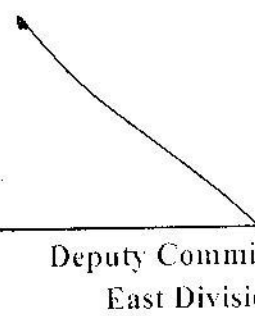
I find nothing wrong as far as concerned RTI Act, 2005 that any suppression of information has been done by the SPIO and Assistant Commissioner of Police in his reply.

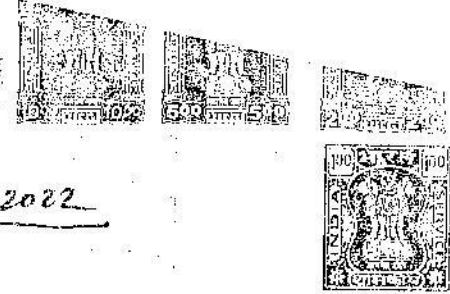
