

Subject: An application for second appeal under section 19(3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, against the Order of the First Appellate Authority & The Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block, dated 09.07.2025 sent vide Memo No. 2492(2)/BHAT-II dated 17.07.2025

Respected Sir,

With due regards, the undersigned and or the appellant herein institutes this instant application of second appeal against the decision and Order of the First Appellate Authority dated 09.07.2025 upon being dissatisfied with the contents and aggrieved by the procedural flout and rigging employed when proceeding with the matter.

FACTS LEADING TO SECOND APPEAL

To put it briefly, the facts relevant are such that, the appellant made an **application under section 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, dated 28.03.2025** (copy annexed with receipt and track report), **before the State Public Information Officer & Joint Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II, Development Block, Kholapota, North 24 Parganas, which was not addressed** in any manner within the stipulated time frame thereby **leading to a complaint under section 18(1)(c)** before this Commission and before the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas, both **dated 02.05.2025** (copies annexed). Soon, an **appeal dated 08.05.2025** was made **before the First Appellate Authority & The Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block** (copy annexed), leading to a **hearing being scheduled on 09.07.2025 at 11 am onwards** and communicated to the appellant vide Memo No. 1275/Bhat-II dated 01.07.2025 (copy annexed). On the date of hearing, the appellant

was badgered and humiliated while being coerced and misled into authoring an inaccurate declaration dated 09.07.2025 (copy annexed). The appellant made a complaint via email dated 09.07.2025 (copy annexed with email details) about the same before the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas, disclosing the abuse and colourable exercise of administrative powers during the quasi-judicial hearing of his matter. The **Order of the first appeal dated 09.07.2025** was eventually passed and communicated to the appellant. Aggrieved by the excessive abuse of administrative powers and post, reflecting in the verbatim of the Order of first appeal, the appellant preferred a complaint dated 25.07.2025 through email before the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas. A further legal notice has been served upon the Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II, Development Block, with respective copies of the same being forwarded to other concerned authorities, entailing the over extension of his administrative interests and role while discharging the quasi-judicial functions of the first appellate authority during the scheduled hearing under the RTI Act, 2005. **Thereafter, this second appeal ensued.** The grounds and prayer of the instant second appeal are under the following paragraphs.

GROUND FOR APPEAL

- I. That, coercion, and undue administrative influence were exerted during the hearing of the first appeal on 09.07.2025 at 11 a.m. in the Chamber of the 1st Appellate Authority for the purpose of obtaining the undersigned and or the appellant's wrongful declaration of non-intimation of any prayer seeking government assistance due to inability and difficulty in availing accommodation and public transport during the period of pandemic/ COVID-19 so as to continue his service in Kholapota Gram Panchayat as Nirman Sahayak. Hence, there had been the violation of the principles of natural justice, i.e., '*fair hearing*'.
- II. That, suppression of facts and documents are implicit in the outcome of the Order, wherein foul play was apparent over the non-consideration of disclosure and complaint made before the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas, with a copy being sent over to the First Appellate Authority & Block Development Officer vide email dated 09.07.2025. The content of such complain entailed deliberate omissions in considering crucial documents (copy of complaint dated 09.07.2025 sent through email are annexed herewith), sent before the administrative office of the Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block, the consideration and perusal of which by an unbiased first appellate authority would have determined the outcome of the hearing of first appeal on merits. The content of such documents are in the nature of prayers made before the Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block seeking assistance during the period of COVID-19 for commuting to office. Under such circumstances, no man of common reasoning and or prudence would write a declaration wherein he would waive his rights unless subjugated by the abuse of power and post into submission.

It so happens that the appellant herein has been misled into authoring such declaration which was realized as being wrong post hearing since all documents pertaining the contents entailing prayer are already within the office records of Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block, District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas and Kholapota Gram Panchayat. Despite of having such information within the administrative records of

the respective Block and others, the appellant was advised to make such declaration else the process of hearing would be postponed. This has prompted the appellant to seek closure on the procedural aspect as to if declaration without verification of official records could be obtained by wrongful means and be thereby justified.

- III. That, the second appeal was presided over by the Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block, who exercised his quasi-judicial powers as the First Appellate Authority while being an interested party in the outcome of the proceedings all together. Factually, the first set of information sought by means of the original application under section 6(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, was to understand if COVID-19 induced prolonged absence at work place attributed to administrative negligence in catering genuine employee concerns would be justified or otherwise. The First Appellate Authority is a stakeholder in the instant appeal since disciplinary proceedings against the appellant were recommended (Memo No.605) and initiated (Memo No.107) by his good office under his seal by virtue of the administrative post held by him in Bashirhat – II Development Block as a Block Development Officer. Personal and departmental bias of the first appellate authority is a violation of the principles of natural justice, i.e., '*one cannot be a judge in his own cause*'. Under such circumstances information likely to be provided to the appellant by the State Public Information Officer as per the directions of the First Appellate Authority would be naturally tainted and lack accuracy. The vested interest of the concerned official discharging the adjudicatory function of the First Appellate Authority in the outcome of the decision is further implicit in the declaration wrongfully extracted from the appellant and addressed to the administrative post held by the appellate authority. Therefore, the Order is corrupted and warrants the instant second appeal.

The appellant cites a decision of the Central Information Commission (CIC/RM/A/2014/004572-SA & CIC/RM/A/2014/004573-SA, paras 6-8) for further pursuance over the issue that an interested party cannot be allowed to hear the appeal of the appellant as first appellate authority as the same breaches the law and the established principles of natural justice.

- IV. That, the information sought in the original application is not barred from being applied for considering the cause of action involved in the pending Writ Petition bearing number WPA/6333/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta. Rather, the information sought herein is ancillary to assisting the issues raised in the petition. No information has been sought in the petition on the subject-matter but only in the original application of RTI herein. In the context of WPA/29020/2024, the information sought therein is in no manner identical or similar to the information sought herein this RTI application. Again, while citing and relying upon a selective excerpt of a Order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in a previous writ petition, being WPA/28836/2022, the first Appellate Authority deliberately suppressed the entirety of the verbatim of the final Order wherein liberty was granted to the petitioner and or the appellant herein to carry out appropriate steps on the basis of the observations made by the Court on the basis of the Report submitted by BDO, Bashirhat-II, Development Block. The nature of such liberty was never limited unless

tantamounts to the abuse of the process of law which has not been breached by the instant RTI application. Again, CPAN/1265/2023 was instituted to redress contempt arising out of non-compliance to the Order passed in WPA/28836/2022. The scope of the first appeal before the first appellate authority being misconceived on such grounds is itself a deliberately conceived reasoning serving his personal interests.

- V. That, the First Appellate Authority's Order also relies upon Notification No. 2804F, dated 05.08.1969 by virtue of which it is claimed that a government employee should ordinarily reside at the Headquarters of the Station to which he is for the time being posted, but as per Rule 29A of the West Bengal Service Rules, Part I, it is not mandatory for a government employee to reside in government headquarters if he is able to discharge his official duties sufficiently while residing elsewhere for personal reasons such as family related concerns or others. Prior to the official steps for initiating departmental proceedings, the appellant made several prayers before the office of The Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block with regard to his difficulty in commuting during the period of COVID-19 but none of such prayers were ever paid attention to. Copies of such prayers are annexed herewith this appeal.

No intimation or reply to such prayers were made or communicated to the appellant in pursuance of being necessary in public interest. Deterioration in official duties due to absence caused by inability to avail accommodation is attributed upon the concerned authority and or the Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block who deemed fit not to redress my concerns but contrarily found it appealing enough to shift administrative accountability and negligence upon the appellant.

Additionally, the scope and or occasion for seeking such prologoned leave during the period of COVID-19 was never exploited by the appellant during such times. What remains an undistorted fact is that the appellant's absence was never wilful or deliberate and the information sought herein are to ascertain the same. The negligent conduct of the Panchayat and Block level administration in catering to the requisites for the smooth running of administration through issuance of Roaster Duty and ID-Cards is their own doing and accountability is liability is to be allocated with accords to the same. The onus to issue official letters with recognized means of receipt in the appellant's name and designation for roaster duty and supply of ID-Cards during COVID-19 rests upon the administration.

PRAYER & RELIEF

The instant appeal is made with a prayer under section 19(8)(a)(i) to obtain the general information sought in the original application within the stipulated time frame, made before the State Public Information Officer dated 28.03.2025 under section 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005. Further prayer is being made against the First Appellate Authority under section 19(8)(b) & (c) for imposing penalty for passing a biased and unjustified Order along with appropriate compensation for causing unnecessary harassment. The appellant prays for appropriate action against the first appellate authority with accordance to the governing law. The Order dated 09.07.2025 has failed to provide the undersigned and or appellant herein with any answer on the second question (b) which sought a general answer as to the nature of extraordinary grounds upon which leave of 262 days maybe sanctioned with or without prior intimation served upon the concerned authority.



With due regards, the undersigned most humbly prays for the supply of information pertaining particulars mentioned below on having furnished appropriate fees for the same:

That, during the period of COVID-19, there was nation-wide lockdown which caused tremendous difficulty in the availability of public transports in the rural areas of the State thus making it impermissible to travel and attend offices without Government issued Id-Cards or other requisites such as Roaster Duty and others, as notified by the Government of West Bengal from time to time in the form of various notifications and guidelines. Therefore, upon non-adherence of any such requisites by the government office such the Block Development Office, Bashirhat- II with regard to the concerns of their employee (Nirman Sahayak) or the undersigned herein, of Kholapota Gram Panchayat has compelled him to remain absent in his work place, situated in the outskirts of the city of Kolkata, wherein pandemic made it impossible to seek rented accommodation. Further, non-availability of necessary means of public transport and various news inflow with regard to the prevalence of pandemic near the undersigned's place of residence, that is Khantura Village, Uttar Para, led to prolonged absence during such period of emergency. Such absence is for 262 days as per Memo. No. 605 dated 23.03.2021, served to the undersigned by the Block Development Officer, Bashirhat-II. Accordingly,

a) kindly provide me with an authenticated copy of reply sought herein as to whether situation induced prolonged absence for 262 days in light of the above mentioned facts can be justified during the period of COVID-19.

b) kindly provide me with an authenticated copy of reply sought herein on the nature of extraordinary grounds upon which leave of 262 days maybe be sanctioned, pre or post availing of such leave, as the case maybe.



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



Sub : - Proposal to frame charges against Shri Sudip Rakshit, NS, Kholapota GP & withheld of pay & allowances therein for unauthorized absence & gross violation of election duty order

Sir,

Your kind attention is being invited to the fact that -

- Shri Sudip Rakshit, Nirman Sahayak of the Kholapota Gram Panchayat is not attending office since 26/06/2020 with no proper reason or leave application.
- He was asked to show cause w.r.t his prolonged absence vide this office letter no(s) 1039, 1065 & 1080 dated - 09/07/2020, 15/07/2020 & 21/07/2020 respectively were issued to him whom you are duly apprised of through proper channel.
- His replies are devoid of merit or beyond consideration.
- In line with the principle of natural justice on 24/07/2020 Shri Sudip Rakshit was asked to appear before the undersigned and he had been given the opportunity of being heard. The undersigned endeavoured in every possible way to make him feel the gravity of the situation prevailing at workplace. But this time too, he failed to bring up any credible evidence in support of his written submission. On the same day one letter addressed to you has been received at this end tendering his resignation from the post of NS. That too, was duly forwarded to your end vide this office letter no. 1104 dated - 28/07/2020.
- On 27/07/2020 a proposal to start departmental proceedings vide this office letter no. 1100 was submitted to your good office but no reply received.
- On 23/09/2020 permission was sought to stop drawing of his pay & allowances vide this office letter no. 1308 but no reply received.
- After the ECI announced the schedule of the General Election to the WBLA-2021 various cells were formed for smooth management of election procedure and every employee on the payroll of this office (including GP) as well as from the line departments were assigned different duties. He was engaged at cell duties related to law & order,

assigned different duties. He was engaged at cell duties related to late VMSO/VMRO, SVEEP vide this office letter no. 520(51) dated - 04/03/21. The same was despatched to his officially recorded address on 09/03/2021 by registered post.

- This time too he didn't report to "Election Duty" which compelled the undersigned to issue show cause letter vide no. 550 dated-15/03/21 in the capacity as ARO, 125-Basirhat Uttar A.C. This time letter delivered to his residential address by special messenger with the direction to appear before the undersigned on 20/03/21. His physical appearance was emphasised again in-line with the Principle of Natural Justice and also to give him an opportunity of being heard.
- He didn't turn up before the undersigned but photocopy of his reply was received (sent via mobile) in which he confessed of being absent for 262 days (since 26/06/2020) without leave application (vide Para-2, line-3 copy enclosed) and categorically stated of not being able to do "Election Duty" (vide Para-1, line-4) with no valid reason.
- His adamant attitude has clearly violated the Sec. 28A, Sec. 134 of the Representation of People Act, 1951, Sec. 187 & 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Rule 15, 29A & Rule 3 of the West Bengal Services Rules, Part-I and provisions of the West Bengal Services (Duties, rights & obligation) Rules, 1980. Moreover, his absence from workplace is therefore, willful and totally unauthorized.
- His imperturbable attitude leaves no room but to make the undersigned, in the capacity of controlling officer and Asstt. R.O (of 125-Basirhat Uttar A.C.), highly disappointed.
- If the issue not taken seriously, his defiant behaviour would send wrong signal to the rest of the employees and that too at this crucial juncture when the paucity of manpower is probably, proving to be a major stumbling block for smooth conduct of ongoing election process.

You are therefore, earnestly requested to frame charges against him for insubordination, unauthorized absence, obstinacy, willful disobedience, dereliction of official duty etc.

As a punitive measure his pay & allowances is being withheld with immediate effect pending outcome of the decision from your end.

Your kind instruction is highly and always solicited.





Respected Sir,

I undersigned Sudip Rakshit, Ex NS of Kholapota GP. would like to state some serious matter against BDO,BASIRHAT-2 who is under your kind administrative control. Today on 9/7/2025 I was attending a hearing scheduled as per memo vide no-1275/Bhat-II dated-1/7/2025 issued by BDO,BASIRHAT-2 and the same was sent via india post vide no RW748261287IN.

During the beginning of hearing at the Chamber of B.D.O,BASIRHAT-2, BDO,BASIRHAT-2 accused and humiliated me stating that,

1. He started verbally to state that many obligation are against me but did not disclose the exact obligation.

2.He verbally stated that why I was absent at Kholapota GP office during COVID-19/ pandamic and was not involved in the development work which was unsatisfactory in the eye of law inspite of not having -

a) Issued any type of Valid I-CARD,to go anywhere during COVID-19 period and inspite of made various Letter by post, email and physically approaching the staff under the administrative control of B.D.O,BASIRHAT-2 to my residence. So many telephonic conversation was made during those time and he asked to know verbally those document but I was not able to submit such document, due to not having those in my possession during hearing. I have already submitted all necessary document and show-cause answer.

b) Issuing valid Roaster duty during COVID-19 period.He asked to know why I was absent during COVID-19 period and not to join at GP office violating various COVID-19 guideline.He insist me some how to engage government work which is not satisfied with legally during hearing.

c)He did not take initiate neither prior nor today to finalise the subming RTI Report mainting RTI Guideline.

d)He did not take initiative to solve the actual service related issues by conducting neither any field visit nor any document checking at kholapota GP.

During hearing he started to state his administrative capabilities and advice me to writing following point which is found wrong in some part and inspite of not resolve the service related issues and also inspite of continuation of WPA 6333 of 2025.He did not sending any RTI Quarry prior. Without verify all the submitting document he had received letter from me which matter is -----

a)"No leave permission was made by me from 26.06.2020 to 8.9.2022."

But the fact is that during those time many WRIT was initiated vide WPA28836 of 2022,CPAN 1265 of 2023, WPA 29020 of 2024, WPA6333 of 2025 including various document related with

the fact of service related issues. He insist me that it is the administrative rules that without maintain Casual Leave guideline, Earned Leave guide line it is justify to present 262 days vide letter memo no 605 dated 23.03.2021 issued by ARO, 125 BASIRHAT UTTAR & BLOCK DEVELOPMENT OFFICER. I am here again submitting some letter of prayer of joining at kholapota GP.

He also trying to insist me to engaging work that is not legal work relating to not maintain COVID-19 guideline and various news flow that is "stay at house and not to go anywhere without any emergency of work" during COVID-19.

b)"Inspite of engaging other GP Employee during COVID-19 period I did not engage in any type of duty at kholapota GP".

But the actual fact is that during COVID19 period it was difficult to go any where with follow various essential government newsflow , without any Valid I-CARD, valid Roaster Duty. It is also noted that BDO, BASIRHAT-2 has engaging other Nirman Sahayak at kholapota GP without resolve the showcause answer and without resolve the various related issues.

c)"During COVID-19 period I did not pray vehicle arrangement and accomodation during period 26.06.2020 to 8.9.2022. No other communication was made on that time."

But the actual fact is that inspite of issueing various Show-cause answer through email, any by sending personnel from BDO, BASIRHAT-2 he did not sending any valid I-CARD rather without resolve the service related issues has engage other Nirman Sahayak, in kholapota GP. With out giving proper justification and without take any hearing/field visit /any other proper punishment procedure. He indirectly would asked to engage some work which is not satisfied in legal procedure.

The nature of work of Nirman Sahayak belong to execute the work and on that basic arranging bill for payment of various agencies. Some monetary involment is there and need to carefully treat. But BDO, BASIRHAT-2 did not guide any thing regarding this.

Further, during hearing I was coerced and misguided into making the written submissions dated 09.07.2025, a copy of which I have already enclosed with this letter of complaint. I did try to refuse the certain false submissions but my efforts were in vain. This submission tend to jeopardize my interest and the means employed for obtaining the same were abuse of administrative powers, and statutory mandates.

Considering the above fact I would request you kindly take some necessary action against it.

Hazira of Sri Sudip Rakshit, Appellant, of the said hearing is taken on record.
Declaration submitted by Sri Sudip Rakshit, Appellant at the time of hearing is taken on record.

It appears from the declaration that the appellant did not pray for leave in terms of the West Bengal Service Rules, Part-I and read with the Sub-Rule 3 of Rule 52 the West Bengal (Gram Panchayat) Administrative Rules, 2006.

Further the appellant stated that the appellant did not pray for accommodation or and arrangements of vehicle to and fro journey from his resident during the Covid-19 restricted period to perform his entrusted duties.

A Government employee should ordinarily reside at the Headquarters of the Station to which he is for the time being posted as per Notification No. 2804F, dated 05.08.1969.

This office arranged vehicle from various point to pick up employees during Covid-19 restricted period for smooth service in the interest of public. But the appellant did not avail the opportunity.

The appellant has willfully violated the assigned duties for this public interest hampered badly in Covid-19 period.

The appellant moved to Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata, in the matter of WPA 28836 of 2022. In this context, the Hon'ble Justice, Shampa Sarkar, passed an order dated 25.01.2023, observed that "the petitioner is a habitual absentee. The petitioner was absent from his duty since June 26, 2020, unauthorisedly. The petitioner was irregular in his duties. From September 9, 2022 the petitioner joined his duty for a brief while and he has been once again absent since November 23, 2022, without any intimation and reason". Further the Hon'ble Justice, Shampa Sarkar observed that 'the allegations of the petitioner are not accepted. Nothing further remains to be decided in the writ petition'.

"However, this order shall not preclude the authorities from taking steps against the petitioner with regard to the petitioner's unauthorized absence in the past.

All such action shall be strictly in accordance with law."

Thereafter the appellant moved to Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata, in the matter of CPAN 1265 of 2023. In this context, the Hon'ble Justice, Shampa Sarkar, passed an order dated 25.01.2023, mentioning the application is misconceived.


And the appellant moved once again the Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata, in the matter of WPA 29020 of 2024 and WPA 6333 of 2025.

The appeal is misconceived.



Respected Sir,

I, Sudip Rakshit, Ex Nirman Sahayak of Kholapota GP received the copy of letter enclosed with a copy of the Order of the First Appellate Authority under the Right to Information Act, 2005 through my father on 21.07.2025 vide Memo No-2492/(2)/Bhat-II Date-17/07/2025 issued by 1st Appellate Authority & B.D.O, BASIRHAT-II. The enclosed letter was received by my father at around 5.30 pm at our residence. The matter is related to the contents of the "ORDER SHEET" passed as of hearing scheduled on 09.07.2025 vide Memo no-1275/Bhat-II Dated-01.07.2025 issued by 1st Appellate Authority & B.D.O, BASIRHAT-II

Prior to narrating the relevant points relating to letter vide Memo No-2492/(2)/Bhat-II Date-17/07/2025 issued by 1st Appellate Authority & B.D.O, BASIRHAT-II, I would like to inform that presently I am posted as Nirman Sahayak at Manipur GP of Sandeshkhali-II Block by means of transfer vide memo no- 333/DPRDO Dated-01/03/2024 and Memo No-330/DPRDO Dated-01/03/2024. I would also enclose some document relating to my service related issues. Necessary documents are enclosed with this letter.

I would like to state the following points relating to "ORDER SHEET" issued by 1st Appellate Authority and BDO, BASIRHAT-II Development Block.

1. In order sheet vide Memo No-2492/(2)/Bhat-II Date-17/07/2025 BDO, BASIRHAT-II state that----*"It appears from declaration that the appellant did not pray for accommodation and arrangement of vehicle....."*

But the actual fact is that during COVID-19 period there was news circulation to stay at house and not to go anywhere without any emergency work and without valid I-CARD. During COVID-19 period there was also newsflow pertaining non-gathering of many people at a time any where. Without valid I-CARD it was not possible to go to required vehicle pickup point for employee. There were directions for issuing "Roaster Duty" for

government employee and also newsflow for common people for abiding by the COVID-19 guideline. During the time of hearing in the chamber of the first appellate authority, he started to humiliate and derogate me on unreasonable and unlawful grounds, which were devoid of prudence and filled with malafides. He started to state his administrative guidelines for doing some activities which were later found unlawful, misleading enough for employee and accompanied with wrong activities fueled by his abuse of administrative and adjudicating powers and post under the Right to Information Act, 2005 and the principles of natural justice, particularly the right to fair and unbiased hearing. The same was informed to superior administrative authority on the same date as of the hearing date, i.e., 09.07.2025. The First Appellate Authority & B.D.O, BASIRHAT-II advised me to write about the above point which was later found to be blatantly inaccurate. Whenever I tried to approach the concerned authority during hearing in order to press it that all necessary documents were already submitted at the receiving section of BDO, BASIRHAT-II including several prayers for joining he did not agree with me and compelled me to write a wrong declaration failure to which I would have to face serious consequences.

During COVID-19 it was impossible for me to go to the required vehicle point position without any valid I-CARD. I would say that in spite of having administrative knowledge and as a local magistrate of BASIRHAT-II Block BDO, BASIRHAT-II did nothing during COVID-19 period for issuing "Roaster Duty", issuing valid I-CARD. Rather BDO, BASIRHAT-II presently coerced and subjugated me to go with wrong guideline for writing the declaration during hearing and the same has been communicated to you in the form of "COMPLAINT LETTER AGAINST BDO, BASIRHAT-II".

2. BDO, BASIRHAT-II also stated in his letter stating---"*It appears from the declaration that the appellant did not pray for leave in terms of the West Bengal Service Rules, Part-I Administrative Rule 2006*"

But the actual fact is that I already submitted so many prayers for joining at Kholapota GP which were received by the office of BDO, BASIRHAT-2 at receiving section. However, BDO, BASIRHAT-2 did not allow me to join at Kholapota GP, did not advise for proper guideline of execution of development work, and later through legal procedure of legal notice and thereafter hearing procedure at DP&RDO, N24PGS vide Memo No-1100/DPRDO Dated-08.09.2022 I was joined at KHOLAPOTA GP. BDO Basirhat 2 did not look about the letter neither earlier nor in present condition. I would like to know why I have to pray for leave during COVID-19 pandemic condition for following newsflow to "stay at home and not to go anywhere without any valid I-CARD" and also the actual fault is that of the administration. On several occasions I prayed to the authority about joining at Kholapota GP, many times I advised the respective authority for paying monthly salary after satisfaction in all respects. I would like to know why my earned leave will be dissolved without solving the departmental procedure and without imposing actual fault of work. I would also know why BDO, BASIRHAT 2 will issue such a letter where casual leave should be calculated after every month end and earned leave should be enjoyed by the employee after sanctioned by the authority. During COVID-19 period Kholapota GP did not issue any "ROASTER DUTY" for allotment of work in rotation basis in pandemic condition, Kholapota GP did not issue any valid I-CARD to me, BDO BASIRHAT 2 did not issue any valid I-CARD, BDO, BASIRHAT-2 did not issue "ROASTER DUTY" for allotment of work at BDO, BASIRHAT-2 office. Rather BDO, BASIRHAT 2 has issued orders for engaging other Nirman Sahayak at Kholapota GP. I would say during COVID-19 period BDO, BASIRHAT-2 was well versed about the process of corruption at Kholapota GP and thus without any proper investigation and imposing proper charges he has ordered for engaging other Nirman Sahayak at Kholapota GP.

3. The Order also relies upon "*A Government Employee should ordinarily reside at the Headquarters of the Station to which he is for the time being posted as per Notification No. 2804F, dated 05.08.1969*".

Regarding this, I would like to state that as per Rule 29A of the West Bengal Service Rules, Part I, it is not mandatory for a government employee to reside in government headquarters if he is able to discharge his official duties sufficiently which residing elsewhere for personal reasons such as family related concerns or others. Prior to my alledged absence, I have made several prayers before the good office of BDO, BASHIRHAT-2 regarding my difficulty in commuting during the period of COVID-19 but none of such prayers were ever paid attention to. No intimation or reply to such prayers were made or communicated to me in pursuance of being necessary in public interest. Deterioration in official duties due to absence caused by inability to avail accomodation is attributed upon the concerned authority who deemed fit not to redress my concerns but contrarily found it appealing enough to shift their accountability and negligence upon me.

4. BDO, BASIRHAT-2 state about ---"*The appellant has willfully violated the assigned duties for this public interest hampered badly in COVID-19.*"

Regarding this I would say that during COVID-19 prodhan kholapota GP did not issue any "ROASTER DUTY" for allotment of work in rotation basis, Prodhan kholapota GP did not issue any valid I-CARD to me, BDO BASIRHAT 2 did not issue any valid I-CARD, BDO, BASIRHAT-2 did not issue "ROASTER DUTY" for allotment of work at BDO, BASIRHAT-2 office. Again I would like to know about details of issueing valid I-CARD and valid "ROASTER DUTY".

I would like to say that BDO, BASIRHAT 2 willfully violated the magistrate level duties for not taking any initiative at field visit and also not for document verification and perusal. I would like to know about detailed calculating procedure of "Attendance Register" during COVID-19.

5. In BDO, BASIRHAT-2 "ORDER SHEET" he stated that....."*The appellant moved to Hon'ble High Court ,kolkata in the matter of WPA 28836 of 2022 .In this context ,the Hon'ble judge Sampa ssSarkar ,passed an order dated 25.01.2023 ,observed that "the petitioner is a habitual absentee....."*

But in this context, BDO, BASIRHAT-2 avoided the verbatim that "*It appears from the report that the petitioner is a habitual absentee.*" and on such basis BDO, BASIRHAT-2 submitted the report wherein it is found that the appellant is a habitual absebtee and thus WPA 6333 of 2025, and WPA 29020 of 2024 were initiated before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta to seek the ceasure of the abuse of administrative powers. BDO, BASIRHAT 2 willfully and intentionally violated the order to cite it in the "ORDER SHEET", with the purpose of influencing the outcome of the appeal.

6. Again he stated "*There after the appellant moved to Hon'ble High Court , Kolkata in the matter of CPAN 1265 of 2023. In this context the Hon'ble Judge ,Shampa Sarkar passed an order dated ,mentioning the application is misconceived*"

But BDO, BASIRHAT-2, did not disclose a certain verbatim from the above-mentioned Order of the Hon'ble High Court that, "*It appears from the order of the District Magistrate, North 24-Parganas that there is already a departmental proceeding pending*", which was

directed to be concluded in accordance with law It is also observed that BDO,BASIRHAT-2 neither take any initiative to complete Departmental Procedure prior to the institution of WPA 6333 of 2025,and WPA 29020 of 2024, nor take any initiative to sending report to DM,N24PGS and thus for a long period of time Departmental Proceedings has being going on.

7. Though it is found that WPA 29020 of 2024 , WPA 6333 of 2025 are going on presently but without observing properly BDO,BASIRHAT-2 has passing a comment "The appeal is misconceived."

Considering the above fact and as per enclosed document of all relating issues I would request you please take some necessary action from your end.

Prior to writing this, I had already submitted the show-cause answer of letter vide Memo No-140/Mani/2024 Date-23.12.2024, of Prodhan, Manipur G.P. and vide memo no-301/SDK-II Date-10/02/2025, vide memo no-302/SDK-II Date-10/02/2025 of BDO, SANDESHKHALI-2 BLOCK.

I was transferred at Manipur GP from kholapota GP under Basirhat-2 Development Block vide memo no-333/1(7)/DPRDO Dated-01/03/2024, memo no-330/DPRDO Dated-01/03/2024. The letter was enclosed with the Departmental proceeding matter vide mentioning letter memo no-107/1(3) Dated-24.01.2023 also. It is also noted that High Court at Calcutta has passed an Order dated 16.01.2023 in respect of vide WPA 28836 of 2022 recording that "The petitioner's contention is that the Pradhan, Kholapota Gram Panchayat had prevented the petitioner from attending the office. Unless the petitioner was ready to carry out certain illegal demands with regard to the process of work issuance of work orders, the Pradhan asked the petitioner not to join the office."

During the time of submitting show-cause answer of letter vide Memo No-140/Mani/2024 Date-23.12.2024, of Prodhan, Manipur G.P. and vide memo no-301/SDK-II Date-10/02/2025, vide memo no-302/SDK-II Date-10/02/2025 of BDO, SANDESHKHALI-2 BLOCK, Prodhan of Manipur GP had issued a Xerox copy of application of present NS of Manipur GP asking me and verbally ordered me to complete the schemes that were stated on the Xerox copy. But it was quite impossible for me to complete the work since the Prodhan of Manipur GP did

not issue any order in my favour for charge hand over from the present NS to me. BDO, SANDESHKHALI-2 also did not take any initiative for issuing any type of letter for charge hand over process. Prodhan of Manipur GP and BDO, SANDESHKHALI-2 did not take any necessary action to disclose the contents and or existence of related document with me. Whenever I made attempts to join at Manipur GP under Sandeshkhali-2 Block, the Prodhan of Manipur GP asked me to complete the billing procedure of said schemes and until so he did not allow me to join at Manipur G.P. BDO sandeshkhali-2 Block nor did he took any action to resolve the matter.

During such period the Secretary of Manipur GP being the appropriate authority for maintaining relevant files did not disclose or furnish to me any type of MB copy or its Xerox, Xerox Copy of Bill, various testing document for various development work, Xerox copy of Completion Certificate of Work of relevant schemes, etc.

Without observing such document it is impossible for me to complete the billing procedure, thus, I request you to kindly allow me to join at Manipur GP under sandeshkhali-2 Development Block and also request you to kindly arrange all the necessary document for smooth implementation of development work and take some necessary action for resolving the joining procedure at Manipur Gram Panchayat under Sandeshkhali-2 Block, North 24 Parganas.

Respected Sir,

I undersigned Sri Sudip Rakshit, presently posting at Manipur Gram Panchayat, Sandeshkhali 2 Block have received your letter vide Memo no-1610 Dated-29/07/2024, Memo no-1610/1(3) Dated-29/7/2024. According your letter and as a Gram Panchayat employee designated as "Nirman Sahayak" you directed me to submit a written clarification why the above noted period should not be treated as "unauthorised" leave. I would like to submit the following reason for why I am absent in Kholapota gram panchayat for those period and which clarification is already submitted in your office and higher authority for taking necessary action during issuing various showcause letter and show-cause answer. A letter vide memo no-1100/DFRDO Dated-2/9/2022 was also issued from DIM(PANCHAYAT) N24PGS to BDO, BASIRHAT 2 BLOCK for taking necessary action for resolve the matter.

1. During period 29/6/20 to 2/9/2022 when COVID-19 was going on NO "ROASTER DUTY" was allotted for doing any official duties under Kholapota Gram Panchayat.
2. No rented house were available to stay surrounding Kholapota gram panchayat area. I already submitted a letter about full lockdown in my resident vide memo no (Municipality order no-Memo No-Covid 22 /GM/COVID-19/20 Dated-14/07/20) collected from reliable sources. News flow was going on to stay at house and not to go anywhere without any emergency of work.
3. No CARD was issued to me for engage covid-19 related work and go anywhere during covid-19 for working purpose.
4. During those period I had collected and downloaded various order related to COVID-19 from "NABANNA" site which is enclosed with this letter. CPAN/1265 of 2022.
5. I would inform you that inspite of giving information and informing "salary should pay after verify all formalities" to BDO, BASIRHAT-2 monthly salary was going on month after month after that question of 262 days unauthorised absent was arise. I would know "why I have to facing unauthorised situation for 262 days in month after month leave calculation matter has arise".

6. I have received on 17/7/2023 about job again to Kholapota office but during those time gram panchayat had no fund to complete all the disburse schemes. During that time it was not possible to me and now granted to me job and this was my salary about 1265 of 2022. I have submitted this letter to BDO, BASIRHAT 2 Block.

7. It is charged specifically "dereliction in discharging in official duties" and also stated that "very irregular in attending office and discharging his assigned duties. According to this I am confused about this. I would like to execute the work and paying related bill after measuring and supervise it at

work site. According to the charge vide memo no-107/DPRDO Dated-24/1/2023, I would again know

a) How much development work was executed by me at Kholapota gram panchayat during my official period before start COVID-19, what was limit to execute the work, and what is status for resolving the letter memo no-1100/DPRDO Dated-8/9/22, Memo no-1100/1(3)/DPRDO Dated-8/9/2022.

b) In which specific case, dereliction of work, is found.

c) In which specific case, insubordination, is found.

d) In which specific case, irregular attending in office, is found.

e) Did I wrong to execute the work after supervise in field.

f) What is official "tour diary" details.

g) Where is roaster duty, details, where is "I card of covid-19 work" details.

The above matter should be under consideration for taking necessary action for smooth execution of Development work.

8. All necessary document has already submitted to BDO, BASIRHAT-2 received section, Kholapota Email id, BDO BASIRHAT-2 email id, also in writ application vide WPA28836 of 2022, contempt application CPAN-1265 OF 2023 initiate by me, also Typological has been send as per your direction.

9. Those period were very painful to me and my family because in spite of exist name in IOSMS portal and in spite of not solving anything my "MONTHLY SALARY" was stopped. I would again know about ROPA 2019 guideline in respect of the situation and despite issue order Memo No-1100/DPRDO Dated-8/9/2022 issued by DPRDO, N24PGS to till now.

10. I would request you kindly look about all necessary document from my date of joining at Kholapota G.P from 19/12/19 till my release from Kholapota G.P. and take necessary action for resolving the official matter.

11. After getting some relief during COVID-19 situation I was appeal to higher authority received letter on 10/6/22, 13/6/22, received letter on 23/5/22, 1/6/22, received letter on 10/5/22 but no response received on that time from higher authority. After that having no favourable situation I initiate a legal notice and sending a notice of "DEMAND JUSTICE" for taking necessary action on 17/11/22 and thereafter through hearing process at DP&RDO, N24PGS I was allow to re-join at Kholapota GP vide Memo No-1100/DPRDO Dated-8/9/2022. The time being held for "discharging of official duties" is not any fault from my end. Again I was appeal to higher authority received on 12/12/2022.

After joining at Kholapota Gram panchayat on 9/9/2022 BDO, BASIRHAT-2 was issued a letter vide memo no-1670/A(6) dated 13/09/2022 for complete of charge handed over and charge taken over process. As per the order of charge handed over and charge taken over process NS, Kholapota GP charge handed over to me for the following schemes which had the following dispute to complete the M.S. During those period whenever I am going to join at Kholapota gp office, panchayat prodhan asking me to complete the charge handed over/charge taken over schemes. Without complete the work I was not allowed to attend at Kholapota gram panchayat office. All details were submitted in written in BDO, BASIRHAT-2 but without considering any issues and not issue any "MAGISTRATE'S HEARING REPORT" of submitted letter and their show cause answer vide

memo no. 273/KIPB/22 Dated: 19/12/2022. I was ordered to report at DP&RDO, N24PGS office vide memo no-125/1(6)/Sht-II Date-3/2/2023, Memo no-107/DPRDO Dated-24/01/2023 for the following reason. The following schemes are

1. Kholapota Gram Panchayat New Building work --- measurement was given, work was done before my re-joining, I wrote a letter for asking clarification and in written on 9/11/2022, but no Magistrate level feedback was received yet.







The undersigned herein, Sudip Rakshit, Ex NS of Kholapota GP, would like to state that, he wants to know about the possible date of the communication of the decision of the hearing conducted on 9/7/2025 as per Memo no-1275/Bhat-II Dated-1/7/2025 issued by you or the First Appellate Authority & BDO, BASIRHAT-2. This is also to remind you that I have already intimated the Respected District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas with regard to what transpired on the date of hearing concerning how my signature and statement was obtained by you.

To reiterate, on 9/7/2025 I attended the scheduled hearing at 11 am as per Memo no-1275/Bhat-II Dated-1/7/2025, sent by India Post vide no RW748261287IN. During the initial hours of the hearing at your Chamber;

1. You accused me that many allegations are against me but did not disclose the exact context and pretext of such allegations.

2. You claimed that I was absent at Kholapota GP office during COVID-19 pandemic situation and did not involve development work which was unsatisfactory in the eye of law in spite of you not having,

a) issued any type of Valid I-CARD, to go anywhere during COVID-19 period and in spite of sending various letters by post, through email and physically approaching of staff under the control of your good office at BASIRHAT-2. Further, many telephonic conversation was made during that time and you asked me verbally about those documents but I was not able to submit such whatsapp conversations and attachments. I already submitted all necessary documents which were received at the receiving section at B.D.O, BASIRHAT-2. The same comprised all show-cause answers, all necessary documents sent by me through email.

b) issued any valid Roaster duty during COVID-19 period. You asked me to know as to why I was absent during COVID-19 period and did not join at GP office by various COVID-19 guideline. He insisted upon me to some how engage in government work which is not satisfied with legally during hearing.

c) You did not take initiative to solve the actual service related issues by conducting any field visit or any document verification in relation to Kholapota GP.

During hearing you started to state your wrong administrative capabilities and advices me to write the following points which are wrong in some crucial parts and consequentially rules out the administrative mishaps of your good office in not having resolved the service related issues and also the pendency of WPA 6333 of 2025. You did not answer any RTI Queries made previously. Without verifying all the documents submitted and letters received from me, I was compelled by your administrative post to write down the following:

a) "No leave permission was made by me from 26.06.2020 to 8.9.2022."

But the fact is that during those time many WRIT was initiated vide WPA28836 of 2022, CPAN 1265 of 2023, WPA 29020 of 2024, WPA 6333 of 2025 including various document related with the fact of service related issues. He insist me that it is the administrative rules that without maintain Casual Leave guideline, Earned Leave guide line it is justify to presenting 262 days vide letter memo no 605 dated 23.03.2021 issued by ARO, 125 BASIRHAT UTTAR & BLOCK DEVELOPMENT OFFICER. I am here again submitting some letter of prayer of joing at kholapota GP. This is to inform you that all letter again were sent on 9/7/2025 through email.

He also trying to insist me to engaging work that is not legal work relating to not maintain COVID-19 guideline and various newsflow that is "stay at house and not to go anywhere without any emergency of work" during COVID-19.

b) "Inspite of engaging other GP Employee during COVID-19 period I did not engage in any type of duty at kholapota GP".

But the actual fact is that during COVID19 period prodhan of kholapota gram panchayat did not issue any roaster duty to me for allotment of work during COVID-19. It was difficult to go any where with follow various essential government newsflow. During COVID-19 police checking was going on at various road for protecting COVID-19 pandemic situation. Without any Valid I-CARD it was very difficult to go anywhere during COVID-19, which should know as a local magistrate. It is also notice that BDO, BASIRHAT-2 had engaging other Nirman Sahayak at kholapota GP without resolve the showcause answer and without resolve the various related issues.

c) "During COVID-19 period I did not pray vehicle arrangement and accomodation during period 26.06.2020 to 8.9.2022. No other communication was made on that time."

But the undistorted and actual fact is that inspite of reverting to various show-cause answer, through email, and by sending employee from BDO, BASIRHAT-2 to my resident, you did not send any valid I-CARD, rather without having resolved the service related issues you engaged another Nirman Sahayakin kholapota GP. Additionally, without rendering proper justification and without taking any initiative in conducting field visit /any other proper punishment procedure, you indirectly tried to engage me with some work which is not justified in law and administrative process.

The actual issue of the undersigned herein was to know the matter of sanctioned procedure of 262 days unauthorised leave and calculating procedure of 262 days unauthorised leave in accordance to the proper government guidelines and administrative decision-making. In spite of informing through letter about the actual condition during COVID-19 and communicating the matter through showcause answers, your good office did nothing to resolve the matter. Rather, the undersigned has been misguided by you wherein you further left no other alternative for the undersigned but to write a wrong letter during hearing under immense pressure inspite of all

necessary letters which were received by the office of BDO, BASIRHAT-2 at the receiving section. After the completion of hearing, during scrutiny it was naturally apparent to me that all necessary verbal guideline of BDO, BASIRHAT-2 were wrong. The same was inform to BDO, BASIRHAT-2 by email on 09/07/2025.

The nature of work of Nirman Sahayak is to execute the work and on that basis bill are arranged for payment of various agencies. Some monetary involvement is there and the same is required to be carefully and honestly dealt with. But you did not provide any guidance regarding this. It is also noticed that you neither took any initiative to resolve or complete the Departmental Procedure nor take any initiative to submit completion report of Departmental Procedure of service related issues of the undersigned/ Sudip Rakshit, Ex NS of Kholapota GP to Dprdo, N24PGS and to DM, N24PGS. Rather it is noticed that Departmental Procedure is going on for a long period of time in spite of issuing transfer order and joining at Manipur GP under Sandeshkhali-2 Block.

Considering the above fact I would request you to kindly take some necessary action in this regard.

1.In your office letter vide memo no-140/mani/2024 date-23/12/2024 you have arise allegation to me I am absent from 12/03/2024 after joining at Manipur Gram Panchayat .But the actual fact is that I have already worked at Manipur Gram Panchayat (Emergency work like "REMAL" vide Memo No-893/SDK-II Dated-26.03.2024 etc) and after joining you also removed me from necessary whatsapp group for monitoring Gram panchayat work "GP & PS Member(Manipur GP)", "Manipur GP Stuff".i would like to request you kindly check again "Attendance Register" to justify the quarries .I would asked to know how a Gram Panchayat can working without "Nirman Sahayak" for long time.

2. you state that in your letter vide memo no-140/Mani/2024 Dated-23.12.2024 you inform me and I was agree to come at gp but I did not join. But I would state that actual fact is that inspite of several communication in telephone with you, inspite of asking to join at Manipur G.P., and inspite of sending show-cause answer of letter vide memo no 1225/SDK-II Dated-31/07/2024,Memo No-1226/SDK-II Dated-31/07/2024 issued by B.D.O,SANDESHKHALI-2 BLOCK (letter was also forwarded to you) no feed-back has received.

3. You inform me and raise point why I am absent but the actual fact is that a department process is going on and I have already submitted necessary letter time to time and prior at Manipur G.P. you advice me not to join at Manipur Gram Panchayat . Inspite of sending answer of issueing letter vide memo no 1225/SDK-II Dated-31/07/2024, Memo No-1226/SDK-II Dated-31/07/2024 issued by B.D.O,SANDESHKHALI-2 BLOCK and inspite of asking to join at Manipur G.P,Sandeshkhali-2 Block you again allegation to me against same SERVICE MATTER and did not allow to join and asking question why I would join join at Manipur G.P. without solving Gram Panchayat related matter.

4. Salary is going on at Manipur GP and no other leave should be applicable against long absence as per your stating allegation and also already departmental proceeding for 262 days unauthorized absence matter is going on and it is pending till now.

5. Letter was issued vide Memo No-333/DPRDO Dated-01/03/2024, Memo No-70/KLPGP(6)/24 Dated-11.03.2024, Memo No-70/KLPGP/24 Dated-11.03.2024 informing and mentioning Departmental Proceeding work is going on vide Memo No-107 Dated-24.01.2023.

6. I would say I would like to join at Manipur Gram Panchayat, Sandeshkhali-2 Development Block that already talk to you and answer of letter vide Memo No-1225/SDK-II Dated-31.07.2024, Memo No-1226/SDK-II Dated-31.07.2024 has already send to you. But whenever I am going to join at Manipur Gram Panchayat you did not allow me to join at Manipur Gram Panchayat. I would like to say that after joining at Manipur G.P., SDK-II Block on 12/03/2024 and working at Manipur G.P. emergency work like Remal, etc before Election work and after completion of Election work on 17/7/2024 Gram Panchayat proddhan refused me to join and refused to allow me performing my duties as N.S. at Manipur G.P. also refused to accept any necessary letter issued by me at Gram Panchayat and advised me to inform the matter to DM, N24PGS. Because the matter of work is not under Manipur G.P., SDK-II Block. I have submitted a letter on 2/07/2024 to DM, N24PGS. I would say DM, N24PGS has also informed the matter to BDO, SDK-II vide Memo No-587/XL/RTI Dated-20/08/2024. Regarding RIL quary issue of show cause answer of vide memo no 1225/SDK-II Dated-31/07/2024. The above matter was stated in show cause answer of letter vide memo no 1225/SDK-II Dated-31/07/2024. It is also noted that no charge handover process has initiate at Manipur G.P.

7. I would state I have completed Reporting before joining at Manipur G.P under Sandeshkhali-2 Block at DP&RDO, NORTH 24 PARGANAS vide Memo No-107/1(3) Dated-24.01.2023 and vide Memo No-125/1(6)/Bht-II Dated-03.02.2023.

I would know why you are giving allegation to me against the above point. I am feeling insecure against your allegation. However I would like to giving answer against your letter vide memo no 140/Mani/24 Date-23.12.2024.

1. A writ petition was initiate vide WPA 28836 of 2022 in respect of Service related issue of Sudip Rakshit, High Court issued a order on 16.01.2023 against this letter stating that-- It appears from the order of District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas that there is already a departmental proceeding pending which was directed to be concluded in accordance with law. The actual fact is that in COVID-19 period when restriction was there to transport anywhere without any valid I-CARD, when no rental house was available surrounding KHOLAPOTA GP area, when there was no "ROASTER DUTY" for SUDIP RAKSHIT to execute work during COVID-19 period, in those time BDO, BASIRHAT-2 has arise a illegal allegation relating to 262 days unauthorized absence and STOP SALARY for long period without issuing any valid ROASTER DUTY and VALID I CARD OF COVID-19. After joining vide Memo No-1100/DPRDO Dated-8.09.2022, issued by DP&RDO, NORTH 24 PARGANAS a Departmental Proceeding is going on relating to Service Related Issue vide Memo No-107 Dated-24.01.2023 by Executive Officer, North 24 Parganas Zilla Parishad stated to BDO, BASIRHAT-2 BLOCK that-- you are directed to start proceeding and frame charges against Sudip Rakshit, Nirman Sahayak, Kholapota G.P. During charge hand over process at kholapota GP some scheme was handed over to me to pay bill. But it was difficult to prepare bill for payment in MEASUREMENT BOOK because the said schemes are already completed at work site before the charge handed over date. Panchayat Proddhan of kholapota Gram Panchayat had refused to join at kholapota GP without doing the billing process of schemes during charge handed over process. I had inform the matter to B.D.O, BASIRHAT-2 on 09-11-2022 for taking necessary action and giving clarification. But without giving any MAGISTRATE LEVEL hearing report at BDO, BASIRHAT2 a letter was initiate vide memo no 107

dated-24.01.2023, issued by Executive Officer, North 24 Parganas Zilla Parishad directed to start proceeding and frame charge of "DERELICTION IN DISCHARGING OFFICIAL DUTIES", "INSUBORDINATION" etc. It is quite difficult to me to execute the work with present Departmental Proceeding situation and without knowing ~~How should execute the work without visiting at work site.~~ I would say that B.D.O, BASIRHAT-2 has issue letter vide Memo No-1610 Dated-29.07.2024, Memo No- 2196/Bhat-II Dated-26.09.2024, Memo No- 125/1(6)/Bht-II Dated- 03.02.2024, after issueing Memo No-107 Dated- 24.01.2023 but did not take any necessary action to frame charge of "Dereliction in Discharging official duties" and "Insubordination" and did not complete the Departmental Proceeding work during working at kholapota Gram Panchayat and till now it is pending. Reporting period in DP&RDO, N24PGS is completed but Departmental Procedure for my service related issue is going on till now.

In present situation I would again request you kindly allow me to work at Manipur GP with proper guidance relating to execution of work at work site and to complete ~~Departmental Proceeding and giving a completion Report about it.~~ And also sending the status report of letter vide Memo No-1100/DPRDO Dated-8.09.2022. issued by Executive Officer, North 24 Parganas.

2. RTI related letter was issued from DISTRICT MAGISTRATE, NORTH 24 PARGANAS vide Memo No-587/XL/RTI Dated- 20.08.2024, Memo No-588/ XL/RTI Dated-20.08.2024, Memo No-507/XL/RTI Dated-25.07.2024, Memo No-436/XL/RTI Dated-27/06/2024 but till now no feedback has received yet.

3. Again I would know from higher authority was this right way to violating law and orders during COVID-19 not to stay at own house, not to follow news-flow of local bodies, Trying to go anywhere without valid I-CARD of COVID19. ~~This point should be solved for 262 days unauthorized leave at Kholapota GP under Basirhat-2 Development Block and leave calculation for future at Manipur Gram Panchayat, Sandeshkhali-2 Development Block.~~ The pending issues of Departmental Procedure is going obstacle to join and working at Manipur Gram Panchayat.

4. I would also state that I have already submitted related letter of showcause answer of "Election Work" , "262 days unauthorized leave" etc. Again I would asked to know when leave calculation of Gram Panchayat employee should completed.

The above stated matter should be answer of your letter vide memo no-140/Mani/2024 Dated- 23.12.2024. I would request you kindly take necessary action regarding service matter at Manipur Gram Panchayat.



According your letter and as Gram Panchayat employee designated as Nirman Sahayak I would noticed you the the following point for smooth process of Administration work .

1. After joining at Manipur Gram Panchayat under sandeshkhali-2 Block on 12/03/2024 at 12.38 pm I have worked and followed as per official guideline. During natural calamities "REMAI" I had worked as per your memo no Memo no-893/SDK-II Dated-26/05/2024. During this time I had post related some picture of beneficiary to "Manipur GP staff" group.
2. During election work though I was not engaged in election work officially but I was in "ELECTION GROUP" to follow the various order as per verbal order of related election official. All necessary document already has been sent to gp mail id, bdo office mail id in other work was allotted before election.

Considering the above point I would like to state that the allegation has no justification. Already I have initiate letter for resolve the matter and also initiate RTI which DIM, N24PGS has been forwarded to BDO, SANDESHKHALI-2 vide memo no 507/XL/RTI Dated-25/07/2024. Pursuant to the intimations and instructions rendered by *my client*, and without prejudice to any other rights and obligations arising out of the matter, this notice is hereby served upon you pertaining your excessive administrative outreach as an administrator of the concerned Block during *my client's* quasi-judicial hearing under the RTI Act, 2005, leading to the violation of the principles of natural justice while tainting the outcome of the decision of the hearing. Prior to enumerating the grounds of your unfettered administrative outreach read with the verbatim to the Order authored by you in the capacity of a First Appellate Authority under the RTI Act, 2005, certain facts are laid out herein under:

That, an appeal dated 08.05.2025 was made before you and or the First Appellate Authority & The Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block, leading to a hearing being scheduled on 09.07.2025 at 11 am onwards and communicated to *my client* vide Memo No. 1275/Bhat-II dated 01.07.2025. On the date of hearing, *my client* was badgered and humiliated by you while being coerced and misled into authoring an inaccurate declaration dated 09.07.2025. Aggrieved, *my client* made a duly enclosed complaint through email dated 09.07.2025 about the same before the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas, disclosing the abuse and colourable exercise of administrative powers during the quasi-judicial hearing of his matter, (*Annexure X*). The Order of the first appeal dated 09.07.2025 was eventually passed and communicated to *my client* vide Memo No. 2492(2)/BHAT-II dated 17.07.2025. Aggrieved by the excessive abuse of administrative powers and post, reflecting in the verbatim of the Order of first appeal, *my client* preferred a second complaint dated 25.07.2025 through email before the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas, (*Annexure Y*).

Now, the grounds relevant for the matter herein are under the following paragraphs:

That, you have violated the right of 'fair hearing' by coercing, misleading and influencing *my client* into authoring a wrongful declaration during the initial minutes of the

hearing which has jeopardized the outcome of the first appeal. The same has been done by way of abuse of administrative post and powers with the objective of safeguarding your personal interests.

That, you exercised undue partiality in the discharge of the quasi-judicial function in appreciating the very fact that the administrative office officiated by you is also administratively empowered in maintaining records with regard to documents placed before them for persusal, record, intimation, appraisal and or necessary action. In the matter of *my client*, such records were in the form of letters of prayer and request for seeking government assistance for accomodataion and transport during the period of COVID-19, made before your good office, among others.

That, in order to serve your personal interests, you further relied upon Notification No. 2804F, dated 05.08.1969 by virtue of which it is claimed that a government employee should ordinarily reside at the Headquarters of the Station to which he is for the time being posted, but as per Rule 29A of the West Bengal Service Rules, Part I, it is not mandatory for a government employee to reside in government headquarters if he is able to discharge his official duties sufficiently while residing elsewhere for personal reasons such as family related concerns or others. Prior to the official steps for initiating departmental proceedings, *my client* made several prayers before your good office and or The Block Development Officer, Bashirhat – II Development Block with regard to his difficulty in commuting during the period of COVID-19 but none of such prayers were ever paid attention to.

That, you discharged your powers as the First Appellate Authority while having vested interest in the outcome of the hearing since the information sought was to understand if administrative non-adherence to government guidelines and notifications issued during COVID-19 in catering the needs of gram panchayat employees leading to prolonged absence for 262 days during the period of COVID-19, would be justified or not. Therefore, by being an interested party you allowed yourself to hear the first appeal and pass a tainted Order. The same is a violation of the principle of natural justice, 'one cannot be a judge in his own cause'. Such was also the decision of the Central Information Commission in CIC/RM/A/2014/004572-SA & CIC/RM/A/2014/004573-SA, *paras* 6-8. Hence, your conduct warrants accountability due to personal and departmental bias.

That, you deliberately cited a selective excerpt from the Order dated 25.01.2023 in WPA/28836/2022, by virtue of which the observation of the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta denoting *my client* to be a habitual absentee was recorded, while suppressing the very fact that such observation was based on the Report sought from you by the Hon'ble Court. You have further suppressed the entirety of such final Order wherein liberty was granted to *my client* by the Hon'ble High Court to take action with accordance to such observation, recorded in the Order dated 25.01.2023.

I, hereby, serve upon you this notice in furtherance to which *my client* shall soon initiate and or institute appropriate legal proceedings to present his grievance before the appropriate forum competent to appreciate and redress.

Commission directs the public authority to explain why compensation of Rs. 50,000/- should not be paid to the appellant.

12. The above directions should be complied within 20 days from the receipt of this order. Commission orders accordingly.

Henceforth, no submission of representation, if any, from your end, will be considered without physical appearance.





Proceedings Before the Commission:

3. The appellant was not present for hearing at stipulated time 12:30 PM. Mr. Sunil Kaura, Jt. Director (Admn), stated that the appellant was terminated due to his poor performance and since then harassing the public authority with vexatious and multiple RTI questions.

4. The appellant arrived at 2:30 PM as he was confused that the time given was 2:30 though it was 12:30 PM in the hearing notice. The Commission was satisfied with the reasons for delay and heard him. During the hearing the appellant stated that he has worked for two years as legal officer in NIOS and that the claim of the CPIO that he was not performing satisfactorily was not correct as his performance was graded as 8 on a scale of 10 in the performance report dated 13.10.2013 signed by Assistant Director (Admin.) and he was recommended for continuation. He said, later, in different ink, some other words were added (after word "recommended") by Mr. Sunil Kaura which changed the recommendations totally, as after tampering, the sentence reads thus; "**.....lack of experience in dealing with legal issues.... however recommended as he may pick up**". This document was also shown by appellant to the Commission and it appeared tampered as some sentences were added in different ink and different handwriting about his recommendations.

5. Appellant said that he wanted two months attendance records of Joint Director, Mr. Sunil Kaura to prove his "tampering" of his performance report as he was not present in office on the day. He further submitted that he was deprived of employment because he pointed out corruption in the institution. They have falsely projected that his performance was not satisfactory by manipulating the reports. Appellant said he is a post graduate in law and has served as a Judge of Senior Citizen Appellate Tribunal at New Delhi in past. He said now he is an active social worker. Appellant is seeking complete point-wise truthful information to prove misconduct of Mr. Sunil Kaura. He also mentioned that Mr. Sunil Kaura was the FAA and he had rejected the appeal.

6. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the principles of law the Commission finds that the public authority, NIOS has breached the law and the settled principles of natural justice by allowing an interested party like Joint Director, Mr. Sunil Kaura to hear appeal of the appellant as FAA resulting in unjustified and biased judgement.

Commission directs the public authority to explain why compensation of Rs. 50,000/- should not be paid to the appellant.

12. The above directions should be complied within 20 days from the receipt of this order. Commission orders accordingly.





From September 9, 2022 the petitioner joined his duty for a brief while and he has been once again absent since November 23, 2022, without any intimation and reason. The Block Development Officer has further stated that the petitioner was free to join his duties.



As the authorities have specifically stated in the report that the petitioner may join his service provided he discharges his duties diligently, the allegations of the petitioner are not accepted. Nothing further remains to be decided in the writ petition.

The petitioner is at liberty to take proper steps on the basis of the observations made hereinabove.

However, this order shall not preclude the authorities from taking steps against the petitioner with regard to the petitioner's unauthorized absence in the past. All such action shall be strictly in accordance with law.

The writ petition is, thus, disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Court on January 25, 2023 as to whether the petitioner may
be allowed to join his service in Kholapota Gram
Panchayat, District-North 24-Parganas.

It appears from the records that the petitioner did
not show any inclination to join the office even after the
order of the District Magistrate. It further appears that the
petitioner was asked to show cause as to why he should
not be proceeded with in terms of the service rules for his
further absence. The Pradhan, Kholapota Gram panchayat
also issued a letter on December 19, 2022 asking the

~~petitioner to attend the gram panchayat office and answer the causes for the unauthorised leave.~~

It appears from the order of the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas that there is already a departmental proceeding pending which was directed to be concluded in accordance with law. Subsequently, the authorities have again issued letters asking the petitioner to show cause as to why the petitioner did not show any inclination to join the service.

The petitioner's contention is that the Pradhan, Kholapota Gram Panchayat had prevented the petitioner from attending the office. Unless the petitioner was ready to carry out certain illegal demands with regard to the process of work issuance of work orders, the Pradhan asked the petitioner not to join the office.

Thus, this Court is of the view that a further report from the Block Development Officer, Basirhat-II Development Block, North 24 Parganas is necessary in this regard, in order to ascertain whether the petitioner can join his service on and from February 1, 2023 or not.

With regard to the period of subsequent absence after the order of the District Magistrate, this Court is of the prima facie view that such absence will be appropriately dealt with by the authorities. However, if the
