

SOUGHT FOR : The appellant herein delineated some facts in the RTI Application dated 05.11.24. The information sought for stated therein concisely as follows:-

(a) The copy of the letter dated 26.02.2009 (as annexed marked with "B" therein) of the District Compensation Officer, Burdwan which was also duly served upon the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur for his information and taking necessary action. Whether after the receipt of the letter dated **26.02.2009** the B.L. & L.R. O.,

Jamalpur has taken and/or carried out any necessary action from his end to assist for disbursement of the said Compensation Amount as stated above till date? If answer is YES, Please furnish what volume of assistance and/or necessary steps with date and specifications have been provided by the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur since **26.02.2009** to **till date**? If answer is NO, what necessary action(s) have been initiated from the District Compensation Officer, Burdwan now Purba Bardhaman thereafter from his end to comply the obligations of the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur till date?

(b) The copy of the letter dated 20.03.2009 (as annexed marked with "C" therein) of the District Compensation Officer, Burdwan which was addressed to the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur for his information and taking necessary action along with a request to reconstruct the C.A. Roll and send to the District Compensation Officer, Burdwan. If answer is NO, what necessary action(s) have been initiated from the end of the B.L. & L.R. Whether after the receipt of the letter dated 10.09.2018 the B.L. & L.R.O., Jamalpur has taken any necessary step from his end treating the urgency of the same upon sending the same to the District Compensation Officer, Purba bardhaman for payment of compensation under reference on and from **10.09.2018/31.10.2018** to till date of this year **2024** to assist the District Compensation Officer, Purba bardhaman for disbursement of the Compensation amount as stated above? If answer is YES, Please furnish what volume of assistance and/or necessary steps on urgent basis are/is provided from the end of the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur. If answer is NO, what necessary action(s) have been initiated from his end to comply his obligation pending for last 6 years to till date?

- (d) WHAT is the status of the letter dated 10.09.2018?
- (e) The copy of the letter dated 26.06.2019 (*as annexed marked with "F" therein*) of the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur which was addressed to the District Compensation Officer, Purba bardhaman wherein the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur has stated "However searching of the BR case is going on". (i) Whether said searching process of the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur is still going on and from the year **2019** to this year **2024** i.e. for last **5(FIVE) years?** (ii) Whether that long drawn searching process is coming to an end or on which date it will be completed? (iii) How much days/months/years are tentatively required to complete the same?
- (f) The copy of the letter dated 29.08.2019 (*as annexed marked with "G" therein*) of the Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal which was addressed to the B.L. & L.R.O., Jamalpur as addressee no. (ii) therein to furnish a detailed report to his department with regard to Settlement of Final compensation case No. 124/J, year 1967-68 and Compensation Assessment Roll No. 3927 Case of Tarapada Pal, Jamalpur

Purba Bardhaman treating the matter as urgent. Has the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur been and/or his concerned officials filed any interim/final detailed report with regard to the matter under reference from his office till date on and from **29.08.2019**? Whether after the receipt of the letter dated 28.03.2023 the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur has initiated any positive step to assist / cooperate the District Compensation Officer for disbursement of said claim of compensation amount? If answer is YES, Please furnish what steps the B.L. & L.R. O., Jamalpur has initiated/carried out from his end. If answer is NO, what necessary action(s) yet to be taken from his end to comply with regard to the disbursement of the same till date?

(h) The copy of the letter dated **31.05.2024** (as annexed marked with "I" here in above) which was duly submitted to the B.L.& L.R.O., Jamalpur through registered post to consider my legitimate claim of Compensation Amount with interest accrued thereof along with seeking some other relevant information with regard to the same. Whether after the receipt of the letter dated

If answer is NO, what necessary action(s) have been initiated from your end to furnish/comply the same?

14. DECISION OF THE 1ST

APPEAL AUTHORITY, IF ANY : i) A notice dated 05.02.25 bearing Memo No 354(32)/130 (2)/E/2025 was duly issued and served by the

Appellate Authority after registering the APPEAL as ***Appeal Case No-04/2025*** to attend the Hearing before The 1st Appellate Authority on 25.02.25 at 12.00 pm,

ii) The scheduled hearing was duly conducted on **25.02.25** in presence of the BL & LRO, Jamalpur and the Appellant and the representing ld. Advocate of the Appellant. It is pertinent to mention here that the BL & LRO, Jamalpur did not utter any single word as his submission with regard to his deliberate negligence, fault, non-providence of the desired reply to the information sought for which the Appellant has been seeking for last **58 years**,

iii) The 1st Appellate Authority did not pay heed at least to direct the SPIO to make reply to all the questions of the Applicant/Appellant herein at an early date which is pending for last **58 years**,

iv) After delivering all the submission by the Appellant and his ld. Advocate the 1st Appellate Authority declared that an appropriate order will be passed in the aforesaid Appeal and it would be communicated to the Appellant accordingly in due course.

v) Thereafter attending to the office of 1st Appellate Authority to obtain the Order sheet/copy of Hearing held on 25.02.25 for numbers of days and months for repeated times yielding no results ultimately the Appellant made a written represented dated 16.04.25 sent through speed post on 17.04.25 accordingly to know the Order of such Hearing but till date no response made from the end of the 1st Appellate Authority.

15. GROUNDS OF 2ND APPEAL

AND THE RELIEF SOUGHT : Some specific and pertinent information were asked in the RTI Application dated 05.11.24 but the SPIO deliberately adamant and neglected to reply the questions upon showing thumb to his responsibility to reply the questions till date which is in contravention and non-compliance with the RTI Laws which is fully against his utmost responsibility as follows:--

a) **Firstly**, the SPIO did not make any reply till date of filing the 1st Appeal to the 1st Appellate Authority i.e. 15.01.25 and for not providing the Information which not only shows his neglecting, arbitrary, avoiding attitude but also his deceptive silence towards the RTI Applicant.

b) **Secondly**, the deceptive silence of the SPIO is clearly tantamount to refusal to inform the queries of the RTI Applicant which is total violation of the provisions of the RTI Act.

c) **Thirdly**, it is pertinent to mention here that in the Hearing before the 1st Appellate Authority on 25.02.25 the SPIO was present and again did not utter any word as his submissions for his deceptive silence for last THREE months (**14.11.24 - 25.02.25**) or more. So this continuous deceptive silence not only clearly admits his gross negligence and adamant attitude but also showing his thumb to the mandatory compliance of him under RTI Laws as the RTI Applicant has been running from pillar to post for his mandatory reliefs waiting for last 58 years for which the RTI Applicant in an urgent search for necessary information.

d) **Fourthly**, the 1st Appellate Authority also did not direct the SPIO to make necessary and urgent reply to the queries of the RTI Applicant which is a gross violation of the duties and responsibilities of the 1st Appellate Authority under RTI laws. Be it also mentioned here that the 1st Appellate Authority is also negligent to pass a necessary order in connection with the Hearing conducted before him on 25.02.25 as the Learned Authority assured in the Hearing that he will pass the necessary order for which the RTI Applicant is in ardent need for the specific and appropriate reply to his queries which can be the only remedy and suffices his purpose for his long pending (**58 years**) legal reliefs and compensation, which is again shows deceptive, arrogant, capricious and arbitrary attitude of the 1st Appellate Authority at large.

e) **Fifthly**, it is very hapless and regretful to submit that the 1st Appellate Authority deliberately avoided and made false assurances verbally to the RTI Applicant when the RTI Applicant have repeatedly attended the office of the 1st Appellate Authority day by day month after month to obtain the necessary order of the Hearing which was duly conducted on 25.02.25, if passed.

f) **Sixthly**, after getting frustrated and being aggrieved of repeated false and deceitful assurance of the 1st Appellate Authority along with the concerned officials of him ultimately the RTI Applicant sent a written representation on 16.04.25 through speed post on 17.04.25 to the 1st Appellate Authority requesting to intimate the Order passed, if any, in the Hearing on 25.02.25 so that he will be able to get his long pending legitimate compensation on the basis of furnished/providence of the necessary Reply either by him or by concerned SPIO but till date no such intimation has yet received with regard to the same.

g) In view of the above, neither the 1st Appellate Authority nor the SPIO failed to apprcciate and look into the true compliance of their respective duties and mandatory compliances under the provisions of the RTI Act as both of them deliberately turned their deaf ears to their respective obligations under the provisions of the RTI Act. It is not out of the way to mention here that both the Authorities, specifically 1st Appellate Authority has been continuously avoiding the RTI Applicant by his dilly dally attitude with a devious mode to dawdle the RTI Applicant for indefinite period so that the RTI Applicant will be tired at his age of 85 years and he will stop running for his necessary reply accordingly.

h) There is no ground available neither to the SPIO nor to the 1st Appellate Authority to refuse the right to seek appropriate and accurate information of the RTI Applicant/Appellant herein in accordance with the provisions of the Right to Information Act,2005 for which only the option left in the hands of the RTI Applicant not only to kick and scream against the SPIO and 1st Appellate Authority for their deliberate deceptive silence with their dilly dally attitude but also to get the necessary and urgent reply to the queries of the RTI Applicant to meet out/get the legitimate compensation which is pending for last 58 years. Hence this 2nd Appeal is filed accordingly.

Reliefs sought : That it is humbly prayed to Your Honour to take strict action against erring SPIO and 1st Appellate Authority and connected Officials by inter alia invoking Section 20 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 with the following prayers :

- i) To provide specific information as asked for from (a) to (i) in the R.T.I. application dated 05.11.24. at an early date,
- ii) Kindly impose penalty on the SPIO under section 19(8)(c) of the Right to Information Act,2005,
- iii) kindly recommend/initiate appropriate administrative step against the SPIO in accordance with section 20(2) of the Right to Information Act,2005 for his deceptive silence knowingly committed by him which is severe violation of the provisions of RTI laws,
- iv) Concerned SPIO should be directed to provide/furnish apropos information as sought for instead of his repeated deceptive silence to the information seeker herein being a senior citizen, making him perplexed and ill-starred for last 58 years,

- v) Kindly invoke powers under RTI Act to issue any other direction or recommendation as Your Honour may deem fit, appropriate and proper.
- vi) Kindly award compensation for the Complainant for pecuniary and other loss.

That for act of kindness your appellant as in duty bound shall ever pray.

16. AS THE 2ND APPEAL

IS FILED WITHIN MANDATED

TIME PERIOD : After conducting the Hearing by the 1st Appellate Authority on **25.02.25** attended by the Appellant herein along with his ld. Advocate in presence of the SPIO, thereafter attending day by day for last 2 months followed by requesting the 1st Appellate Authority upon sending the written representation on **16.04.25** posted through speed post on **17.04.25** yielded no result at all for repeated tries and being frustrated by the dilly dally attitude of the 1st Appellate Authority to dawdle the RTI Applicant for indefinite and in ordinate delay this 2nd Appeal is filed within the

Prescribed time limit in accordance with the section 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005. If any delay is made which is only out of the false assurance on the part of the 1st Appellate Authority to frustrate the RTI Applicant being a senior citizen to wait for indefinite period may be condoned for the ends of justice.





Sub : Request to provide information under the provisions of the Right to Information Act.

Sir,

With due respect I, SWAPAN PAL of Vill-Sahapur, P.O.-Parbatpur, P.S.-Jamalpur, Dist-Purba Bardhaman, Pin-713408 want to address as follows:-

1. That one, Sri Tara Pada Paul, my father was entitled to get a Compensation amount of Rs.7237.19/- (Seven Thousand Two Hundred Thirty Seven and paisa Nineteen herein after referred to as "Said Compensation Amount") in F. P. case no. 124/J/1967-68 UNDER Compensation Assessment Roll no. 3927 along with interest accrued thereof as the then intermediary in accordance with the provisions of the West Bengal Estate Acquisition Act, 1953 and rules framed there under against vesting of some landed property of him which was duly intimated to him in the year 1968. But he was unable to get the said Compensation Amount during his life time after his repeated efforts and died on 22.02.1991. Be it mentioned here that after getting the knowledge from some important and relevant original papers and correspondences I attended and approached the District Compensation Officer, Bardhaman for repeated times to get the Compensation Amount and ultimately

submitted written representation on 27.06.96 (R.L. no.4992) and on 08.08.1996 (R.L. no. 3012) but no positive initiations have been carried out to disburse the aforesaid compensation till 2005.

2. That after being aggrieved out of dilatory acts and conducts from your ends I immediately wrote again another letter on 29.12.2005 to the District Compensation Officer of Burdwan with regard to the entitlement of the aforesaid Compensation Amount of my deceased father and in response to that I have been directed to submit all the relevant documents including duly filled in Verified Statements by virtue of the letter bearing Memo No. 27/Comp/FP dated 6.2.06 issued by the District Compensation Officer of Burdwan dated 06.02.06 which I carried out accordingly. The photo copy of the Letter dated 06.02.06 is annexed herewith and marked with letter "A". (Page - 10 running).

3. That I have attended each and every concerned office of the Government of West Bengal to realize the legitimate claim of said Compensation Amount but after no stone unturned I submitted an application on 18.02.2009 addressed to the District Compensation Officer to seek information under the provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005 about the status of the legitimate claim of said Compensation Amount in response to which I have been directed to appear before the District Compensation Officer, Burdwan on 18.03.2009 at 1-00 pm and I attended with all relevant documents in original accordingly. It is not out of the way to mention here that the payment of the legitimate claim of said Compensation Amount will be disbursed after getting the reconstructed C. A. Roll from the B.L. & L R O office, Jamalpur who is the appropriate authority to reconstruct the said C.A. Roll under the provision of Rule 2C of Schedule-E of Section -54(2) of W.B:E.A. Rules, 1954. The photo copy of the Letter dated 26.02.2009 of District Compensation Officer, Burdwan is annexed herewith and marked with letter "B". (running page 11-12)

4. That it is also pertinent to mention here that the District Compensation Officer also sent another letter dated 20.03.2009 the B.L. & L. R. O.- Jamalpur requesting "to re-construct the C.A. Roll under the provision of the aforesaid Rule and sent the same to this end for payment of compensation as early as possible". The copy of the requesting letter dated 20.03.2009 was also duly forwarded/served to the A.D.M. & D.L. & L.R.O for his kind information and taking n.a. AND to me for information accordingly. The photo copy of the Letter dated 20.03.2009 is annexed herewith and marked with letter "C". (Running page - 13)

5. That after lapse of one year I submitted written representation on 23.04.2010 to the B.L. & L R O office, Jamalpur through registered post in response to which I have attended to the office of the B.L. & L R O, Jamalpur on 09.08.2010 in compliance with the direction of his letter dated 23.07.2010 accordingly.

6. That it is also pertinent to mention here that I sent my written representations dated **10.05.2010 and 28.09.2010** to the A.D.M. & D.L.L.R.O with an ardent request to carry out the reconstruction of C.A. Roll for payment of said Compensation Amount but all efforts yielded no results at all. The photo copies of the Letter dated **10.05.2010 and 28.09.2010** are annexed herewith and marked with letter "D" collectively. (Running page 14-15)

7. Thereafter I pursued my claim month after month and year after year but no such effective step was taken from any end for disbursement of the legitimate claim of said Compensation Amount but after a long period even decade the District Compensation Officer sent a letter bearing Memo No. 92/ COMP dated **10.09.2018** to the B.L. & L R O, Jamalpur directing "He is therefore requested to look into the matter and take necessary action from his end for sending the said report viz- Transfer Certificate, Damage Compensation and Possession Certificate to this end at the earliest. This may be treated as an

extremely urgent". The photo copy of the Letter dated 10.09.2018 is annexed herewith and marked with letter "E". (Page-19)

8. That in compliance to the letter of the District Compensation Officer dated 10.09.2018 the B.L. & L.R.O, Jamalpur replied "However searching of the BR case is going on." through his letter dated 26.06.2019 bearing Memo No. 420/JMP/2019 the copy of which was also served upon me. The photo copy of the Letter dated 26.06.2019 is annexed herewith and marked with letter "F". (Page-20)

9. That it is to note here that the Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal specifically directed (1) The D.L. & L.R.O., Purba Bardhaman and (2) The B.L. & L.R.O., Jamalpur, Purba Bardhaman to settle the final compensation case 124/J, year 1967-68 and Compensation Assessment Roll No. 3927 of Tarapada Pal, Jamalpur, Purba Bardhaman mentioning "the undersigned is directed to request him to kindly furnish a detailed report on this matter to this Department at an early date. Accordingly an Offer Notice along with a Verified Statement Form were sent to the said Tarapada Pal on 15/06/1968 which was duly received by Tarapada Pal as is evident from this office records. But neither the said Tarapada Pal nor any representative of Tarapada Pal submitted the Verified Statement Form, duly filled in, to this office; nor anyone approached on behalf of Tarapada Pal to this office to show his interest to take payment of compensation, though the amount of compensation (Rs. 7237=19) + the interest thereof was not a mere negligible amount at that time. R.O.C.

It also appears from this office records that the said Tarapada Pal died in 1991. So the office is quite in dark as to why Tarapada Pal was kept silent regarding taking of payment of compensation for the long period of 23 years till his death!

Moreover, after the death of Tarapada Pal in 1991, none on behalf of Tarapada Pal approached this office for taking payment of compensation till 2006, i.e. for a period of another 15 years!

The above circumstances clearly proves that the said file i.e. the F.P.C. Case No. 124/J/1967-68 was un-touched for the long period of 38 years. And as a result the file is not readily available in the office. It is either destroyed or damaged or misplaced in the heap of consigned





It must be mentioned here that this is his legitimate claim, which, we hope, you must admit. It is a clear matter of understanding. It simply requires your sincerity and interest with a positive thinking. Ld Lawyer Sri Choudhury had already calculated the amount of demand of the claimant. We find that it is his bonafide and legitimate claim. It is fact that the claimant is not begging for money. He simply asked for payment of his legitimate dues for which his property had been hold from a long year.

Anyway, we request you kindly throw a light in the matter to us for onward transmission to the claimant. Actually, his claim presently comes to Rs. 77,581/- which excludes interest; since he is entitled to reasonable interest for his money.

We solicit your reasonable reply with your views in the matter.

With reference to your petition dated 18/02/2009 u/s Right to Information Act, 2005, the undersigned would like to inform you that a F.P. Case No. 124 / J / 1967-68 u/s 23 of the W.B.E.A. Act, 1953 for payment of compensation had been started in the name of the then Intermediary Tarapada Pal s/o Prasanna Kumar Pal of Vill. - Sahapur, P.O. - Parbatpur, Dist. - Burdwan. Accordingly an Offer Notice along with a Verified Statement Form were sent to the said Tarapada Pal on 15/06/1968, which was duly received by Tarapada Pal as is evident from this office records. But neither the said Tarapada Pal nor any representative of Tarapada Pal submitted the Verified Statement Form, duly filled in, to this office; nor anyone approached on behalf of Tarapada Pal to this office to show his interest to take payment of compensation, though the amount of compensation (Rs. 7237=19) + the interest thereof was not a mere negligible amount at that time.

It also appears from this office records that the said Tarapada Pal died in 1991. So the office is quite in dark as to why Tarapada Pal was kept silent regarding taking of payment of compensation for the long period of 23 years till his death!

Moreover, after the death of Tarapada Pal in 1991, none on behalf of Tarapada Pal approached this office for taking payment of compensation till 2006, i.e. for a period of another 15 years.

The above circumstances clearly proves that the said file i.e. the F.P. Case No. 124/J/1967-68 was un-touched for the long period of 38 years. And as a result the file is not readily available in the office. It is either destroyed or damaged or misplaced in the heap of consigned
