With reference to reply of the SPIO (Letter Ref No. SPIO/TP/RTI/71/24 Dated 18.09.2024, I received incomplete information.

Subsequently with reference to reply of the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority (Letter Ref No. 18836/PA/DCTP Dated 08.11.2024, I received unsatisfied reply. Therefore 1<sup>st</sup> Appeal is being filed on following ground:

**Ground of Appeal:**

I had requested CCTV footage based on my application, but the SPIO has responded that the footage is unavailable. It is crucial to highlight that preserving CCTV footage is of paramount importance, especially when a case is based on such evidence. Failure to provide this footage to citizens constitutes a violation of human rights and calls into question the validity of the case itself.

The requirement for CCTV footage is essential to understand the process of imposing cases for violations of traffic guidelines. Providing access to this footage ensures transparency in the enforcement process, fostering accountability and building trust among citizens. This measure will greatly benefit the public by promoting fairness and clarity in the application of traffic regulations.

Under the Constitution of India, every citizen has the right to access the details and evidence of any case imposed upon them, to ensure their rights are protected under the law. In a democratic country like ours, withholding essential evidence such as CCTV footage not only undermines justice but may also render the imposed case null and void.

I respectfully bring to your attention the decision made on my First Appeal by the Appellate Authority, which stated:
