

My Case Number AC-272 OF 2017 is under the Judgeship of the Honourable LD. 2ND JM, Alipore, Kolkata, South 24 Parganas which is under the jurisdiction of the Honourable LD. District Judge, South 24 Parganas.

The un-investigated and non-verified DIR has been submitted by the then Protection Officer in this Court dated 16.05.2017 which was after the Ex-parte decree of Divorce dated 24.04.2017 based on U/s 13(1)(ia)(ib). That Your Honours, the Protection Officer has never made any endeavour to contact the respondent and his aged parents to know their version against the version of the petitioner, thus the DIR is absolutely biased, false, baseless, un-investigated and concocted. That Your Honours, the respondent and his aged parents have suffered an irreparable loss and injury for passing and granting interim relief on the basis of such biased, false, baseless, un-investigated and concocted DIR. Had the Protection Officer investigated and enquired properly, the truth must have come out which might have helped this LD. Court to reach a true, fair and unbiased decision at the time of disposing of the interim application. The DIR was never verified and investigated by the Protection Officer and the same was never summoned to the respondent and his aged parents. Neither the respondent nor his parents were given any fair opportunity of being heard which is a violation of the Fundamental Rights as mentioned in the Article 14 and in the Article 21 of the Indian Constitution.

In the light of the above mentioned background, please provide the following information under section 2(f) and 2(j) of the RTI act:

- ✓1) The reasons as per the records for not referring the two notable judgements in my case - Priti Gupta vs Promod Gupta on 10 February, 2017 and Santosh Bakshi vs State Of Punjab And Ors on 30 June, 2014.

- ✓3) The reason for harassing me despite of knowing the fact that post the ex-parte decree of divorce dated 24.04.2017, I got remarried on 04.05.2018 to Mrs. Lipika Palit and is also having an infant child aged 5 months.

- 4) The reason for not allowing me and my parents in visiting my son from the previous marriage despite of transferring money from the SBI ACCOUNT (respondent) to the BOB ACCOUNT (petitioner) over a certain period of time. I would also like to know the name of the school in which my son is studying, the class in which my son is reading and the fees structure of the school.
- 5) The reason for granting interim maintenance to the ex-wife vide order dated 27.12.2018 without providing a single evidence related to the physical violence, verbal and emotional abuse, economic negligence, mental abuse, and sexual abuse.
- 6) The reason for overlooking the ex-parte decree of divorce order dated 24.04.2017 based on U/s 13(1)(ia)(ib) vide order no. MAT SUITE 248 of 2016. *
- 7) The reason for overlooking the DIR challenge on 24.08.2017.
- 8) The reason for overlooking the DIR challenge on 30.11.2021. This application contains all the relevant evidence against the entire DIR. In this DIR challenge application - physical violence, verbal and emotional abuse, economic negligence, mental abuse, emotional abuse have been falsified with evidence.
- 9) The reason for overlooking the point number 7 & 8 in the DIR challenge application dated 30.11.2021 where it is mentioned with dates when and where the police complaints and the GDEs have been registered against the petitioner and her parental relatives.
- 10) The reason for overlooking the point - a wife who has deserted her husband willfully and without any sufficient and cogent reason is not entitled for any maintenance. This has already been proven in the ex-parte decree of divorce order on 24.04.2017.
- 11) The reason for overlooking the fact that the petitioner being highly qualified (B.A., M.A., M.PHIL appeared, C.TET appeared, B.ED as mentioned in her statement) is expected to appear in the Court with clean hands but she has appeared in the Court with unclean hands. The petitioner has worked at the Kendriya Vidyalaya Balasore, Odisha, Pin - 756001 (Gross Salary Rs. 21,000/- P.M., Net Salary Rs. 18,750/- P.M.). The petitioner has also worked at Maharishi Vidyamandir, Shilpa Park, Kondapur, Hyderabad, Pin - 500084 (Net Salary Rs.

12,000/- P.M., Gross Salary Rs. 14,000/-). As such she is eligible and capable enough to maintain herself and hence she is not entitled to any maintenance or monetary compensation from the respondent.



10) The reason for overlooking the point - a wife who has deserted her husband willfully and without any sufficient and cogent reason is not entitled for any maintenance. This has already been proven in the ex-parte decree of divorce order on 24.04.2017.

11) The reason for overlooking the fact that the petitioner being highly qualified (B.A., M.A., M.PHIL appeared, C.TET appeared, B.ED as mentioned in her statement) is expected to appear in the Court with clean hands but she has appeared in the Court with unclean hands. The petitioner has worked at the Kendriya Vidyalaya Balasore, Odisha, Pin - 756001 (Gross Salary Rs. 21,000/- P.M., Net Salary Rs. 18,750/- P.M.). The petitioner has also worked at Maharishi Vidyamandir, Shilpa Park, Kondapur, Hyderabad, Pin - 500084 (Net Salary Rs. 12,000/- P.M., Gross Salary Rs. 14,000/-). As such she is eligible and capable enough to maintain herself and hence she is not entitled to any maintenance or monetary compensation from the respondent.

6. Particulars of Decision of SPIO:

No response received

7. Brief facts of the case:

The reasons as per the records for not referring the two notable judgements in my case - Priti Gupta vs Promod Gupta on 10 February, 2017 and Santosh Bakshi vs State Of Punjab And Ors on 30 June, 2014.

The copy of the RTI application has been attached herewith as Annexure 1.

3. Reasons/grounds for this appeal:

1. As there was no reply from the Public Information Officer, to the RTI application dated 11/04/2022 within 30 days, an appeal is preferred before the First Appellate Authority under the Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
2. Under the RTI Act, 2005, a PIO is obliged to provide access to information to a citizen unless as stipulated by Section 7 (1), furnishing of such information is covered by one of the exemptions provided under Section 8 or Section 9 of the RTI Act.
3. The PIO has failed to discharge its duties and obligations and has adopted a lackadaisical approach towards dealing with the RTI application by not responding within 30 days of the application.
4. The PIO has failed to inform the applicant as to why this information has not been disclosed to the applicant and its reasons thereof. Section 4 (1) (d) of the RTI Act clearly lays down that every public authority shall have to disclose the reasons for its decisions to the affected persons.
5. It is obligatory upon the PIO to disclose the information as requested by the applicant. The request of the applicant squarely falls within the definition of right to information under Section 2 (j) of RTI Act read with Section 2 (f) and 2 (i) relating to the definition of information and record. The applicant in his RTI application has clearly enumerated the information which he desires and there is no ground whatsoever for the PIO to not to provide him the complete information.

This First Appeal is accompanied by an application for condonation of delay in filing the First Appeal within the stipulated time as prescribed in Section 19 (1) of the RTI Act, 2005 at Annexure 2.
