ay only son - Raja Mallick lost his life at the age of only 16 Yrs: on 20-Sep-2005 due to extreme negligence by the doctors. Even after 16 Yrs of continuous efforts & having approached various authorities, I have not received any justice till date. Upon approaching the Kotwali Police Station, my allegation was initiated vide case no. 383/2006. Neutral judgment given by a bench of doctors clearly concludes that the guilty doctors already knew about the wrong injection which was given to Raja Mallick causing his death. But due to intentional filing of wrong charge sheet and / or the culprits being acquitted by the police authorities, I have been denied justice. At the end Investigation officer only filed charge sheet for minor an ences against 2 doctors instead of 4 guilty doctors under Section 304 (A) of IFC in the court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate in Nadia district. (Case No. 1539/06, Charge sheet dated 25.09.2011). I have knocked the door of Union Home Ministry, respected Chief Minister (West Bengal), highest level of police administration (West Bengal) and various other authorities within my reach however no solid action has been taken yet. In support of my allegation, I am herewith providing the following documents to support my claim which will definitely prove that not only Dr. Hiren Mukherjee and Dr. K.R.Biswas but there are few more doctors and their colleagues who are responsible for the negligence and subsequent death of my only son.

With the help of attached supporting documents it can be substantiated that by the influence of political leaders, individual interests, and / or by monetary power police investigation report can be altered or false report can be submitted. I am attaching herewith all the supporting photocopies to show my claim.

- Anticipatory bail application U/s 438 Cr.P.C by Dr. Hiren Mukherjee +1 dated 13-07-2010 and subsequent rejection order of the same in the court of Session Judges. Nadia. Krishnagar shall also speak the title scenario in this regard is attached herewith for your kind perusal where the Ld. Court has also questioned the "Sinister motive" of the Enquiry committee.
- P.S Sri Chandan Banerjee to S.P Nadia clearly mentioned that the Ld. C.J.M, Nadia go through the case diary and was not satisfied by investigation report submitted by the I.O C.I.D, W.B, and passed an order to reopen the case with a direction to investigate the case by another I.O from where it can be deduced that the motive of

From the above mentioned documents particularly point no. 4, 5, 6 & 7 it can be surely deduced that Mr. Arun Das, the same person has given 2 different views on the same points i.e. 1st time he has confirmed the section 304 (2) and 2nd time he mentioned section 304 (A).

From the point no. Z & 3 it can be deduced that section 304 (2) and section 201 should be imposed on the culprits.

From the point no. 6 & 7 it can be deduced that my allegation has not been granted properly. Moreover they have mentioned me as a Mentally Imbalanced person. Also, misleading report (12-12-2005) has been furnished by Dr. R.B.Dutta, Dy. C.M.O.H-II Nadia, Dr. S.Seal D.M.C.H.O. Nadia, Dr. L.K.Hatui, Dy. C.M.O.H-III Nadia.

From the point no. 8 & 9 it can be deduced that Ld.Court has clearly constructed write-Codere-in-the-vistority allegations and questioned liber council to the investigating authority as well as of the "Enquiry Committee" remed by the West Bengal Medical council.

Being a helpless village farmer and an unfortunate father, I am begging for the appropriate intervention from your end so that I can get justice for my only son's untimely death.
