The Appellant most respectfully submits:

1. That the Appellant filed RTI Application dated 03.09.2023 (Annexure-1, Pg. 4) seeking specific information on grievance No. GINC17072023862425 concerning road construction from Mohanpur Hospital to Mohanpur Hatt. This was sent via Speed Post (Consignment No. EW339139525IN), duly received by Respondent on 08.09.2023.
