

Being dissatisfied and aggrieved by not receiving appropriate information within the time specified in sub-Section (1) or clause (a) of Sub-Section (3) of Section 7 within 30 days from the expiry of the said period from The Superintendent of Police, Diamond Harbour Police District, by way of an application under Section 6(1) of RTI Act dated 16.05.2024, the Complainant herein preferred this instant complaint under Section 18 of the Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005 on the following grounds/reasons as follows.

Most Respectfully Sheweth:-

Brief facts leading to the Complaint:-

1. That for the purpose of better understanding the application u/s 6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 dated 16.05.2024, preferred by the complainant is hereinafter called and referred to as the "said RTI application".
2. Your complainant respectfully submits that it has been requested to the respondent authority to kindly provide the complainant, the "information" in regard to the Current status of the letter of Complaint dated 30.04.2024 lodged before the Officer-in-Charge of Maheshtala Police Station as an information disclosing cognizable offense under Section 154(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

3. Your complainant respectfully submits that it has been requested to the respondent authority to kindly provide the complainant, the "information" in regard to the day to day progress as to the steps taken by the concerned authority, after receiving the said Letter of Complaint dated 30.04.2024 lodged before the Officer-in-Charge of Maheshtala Police Station as an information disclosing cognizable offense under Section 154(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
4. Your complainant respectfully states and submits that it has been further requested to the respondent authority to kindly provide me, the information in regard to the name, particulars & designation of the officer who has been entrusted to deal with the said Letter of Complaint dated 30.04.2024 received by the Officer-in-Charge of Maheshtala Police Station.
5. Your petitioner respectfully states that it has been further requested to inform me, to provide the appropriate information in regard to the reasons of law for not treating the said Letter of Complaint dated 30.04.2024 and to supply adequate information in regard to the reasons for not doing the same under Section 7(8) of the Right to Information Act.

Photocopy of the Letter of Complaint dated 30.04.2024 lodged before the Officer-in-Charge of Maheshtala Police Station, is annexed herewith and marked as letter "P-1" for your kind perusal.

Photocopy of the said RTI application dated 16.05.2024 received by the authority on 17.05.2024, is annexed herewith along with the postal receipt and track consignment report collectively and marked as letter "P-2" for your kind perusal.

6. That the complainant most humbly states that the SPIO/respondent authority mala-fide denied/refused to provide appropriate information

in regard to the RTI application dated 16.05.2024, preferred by the applicant/complainant, namely, Ipshita Chakraborty and the respondent intentionally refused and neglected to provide the required information for the purpose of taking appropriate action against the Letter of Complaint dated 30.04.2024 lodged before the Officer-in-Charge of Maheshtala Police Station.

7. The complainant being aggrieved and dissatisfied by, "Not receiving a decision" begs to prefer this complaint on the following amongst other grounds:-

GROUNDS

- I. FOR THAT the SPIO/Respondent failed/neglected/refused to provide relevant information against the query No. 1, 2 and 3 of the "said RTI application" dated 16.05.2024.
- II. FOR THAT the SPIO/Respondent intentionally acted escapist to provide your complainant the appropriate information in regard to the steps taken by your authority after receiving the Letter of Complaint dated 30.04.2024 lodged before the Officer-in-Charge of Maheshtala Police Station.
- III. FOR THAT the SPIO/Respondent mala-fide denied/refused to disclose the materials on record and otherwise intentionally had certain material on record by commission or omission.
- IV. FOR THAT the SPIO/Respondent is duty-bound to supply/ provide appropriate information as sought by your complainant.
- V. FOR THAT the SPIO/Respondent failed to record any cogent reason for not providing the required information to the complainant and failed to dispose the RTI application dated 16.05.2024, under Section 6(1) of the RTI Act as per Sub-Section (1) or clause (a) of Sub-Section

(3) of Section 7 within 30 days from the expiry of the said period in accordance with law.

8. This application is made bonafide for the ends of Justice.

In view of the above-mentioned facts and circumstances the Complainant herein prays for certain relief or reliefs as under:-

- a. A direction upon the SPIO to provide/furnishing the appropriate information as sought for in the application under section 6(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 dated 16.05.2024.
- b. For imposing a penalty on the SPIO of Two hundred and fifty Rupees per day till the day the information is furnished to the Complainant.

And for this act of kindness, your petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.

Sub: - Serious Complaint against the Accused Persons namely(1) Rudra Narayan Chakraborty (Husband), son of Late Ranendra Narayan Chakraborty; (2) Dipali Chakraborty (mother-in-law), wife of Late Ranendra Narayan Chakraborty; (3) Rathindra Narayan Chakraborty (uncle-in-law); (4) Swapna Chakraborty and (5) Shubhra Chakraborty (both sisters of Late Ranendra Narayan Chakraborty); (6) Rup Narayan Chakraborty (brother of my husband); (7) Tinku Guha Chakraborty, wife of Rupnarayan Chakraborty, all are residing at Paschim Jagtala Maheshtala, Back side of Maheshtala Police Station. Pin 700141, Maheshtala, South 24 Parganas - 700141, Landmark - Behind Maheshtala P.S. under Maheshtala Police Station, for registering a Criminal Case/F.I.R. against the accused persons.

Respected Sir,

I, Ipshita Chakraborty, wife of Rudra Narayan Chakraborty, presently residing at 35/4/6 Baksara, Road Howrah 711110. Near Nabachakra club, Police Station A.J.C Bose, Botanical Garden, do hereby state to inform your kind authority that I got engaged as the married spouse of one Rudra Narayan Chakraborty through a registered marriage dated 08/10/2021 under the Hindu Marriage Act, 1954 and subsequently the said marriage was solemnized on 02/02/2022, following Hindu rites, rituals and customs. Since the very inception of the said marriage, my husband, my mother-in-law, the uncle of my husband, the sisters of my father-in-law, the brother of my husband and his wife, started abusing me mentally, physically and assaulted me and I was regularly threatened to be thrown

out of my in-laws' house. From the very inception of the said marriage my husband and my in-laws used to torture me physically and mentally, I was not provided with adequate fooding for which I had to live under severe starvation. I was compelled to sell some of my ornaments to lead my bare sustenance. On several occasions my husband physically assaulted me, my husband once bit me for which I sustained injury on my head. My husband and in laws used to torture me for bringing dowry from my paternal relatives. None of my in laws used to spare me from regular course of torture. The only reason for such atrocities committed over me was to drive me out from my matrimonial home. My Stridhan Articles which were entrusted by me to my husband and my in-laws on a condition that the same will be returned to me as and when I will ask for them, but the same has been retained by them. I was ousted from my matrimonial home on 24th December, 2023. I was finally driven out from my matrimonial home by my husband & my in-laws conjointly. Thereafter, under such conditions, I had to take shelter in my paternal home at the address mentioned above. My husband & my in-laws used to be stigmatized as a patient of depression. The list of stridhan articles retained by my husband and my in-laws are hereinafter mentioned below.

It is pertinent to mention to your kind authority that due to such an immense mental torture, I suffered from depression and I had to take medications for countering the said condition. My husband and my in-laws made it a laughing stock and I was intentionally refused to have an adequate meal by my husband and my in-laws despite knowing that having food cravings is one of the side effects of the medications for depression.

On one occassion, my husband bit me and hit me hard on my head which resulted in swelling of that region of my head, since I ate some cashew and raisins while having food cravings. On another occasion, my husband poured Fenyle on my whole body and tore my nighty into two, in front of his

whole family by disrobing me to outrage my modesty under the direct instigation of my in-laws.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances, it is requested to your kind authority to please treat this letter of complaint as an information disclosing cognizable offenses like domestic violence, mental abuse, physical assault and criminal breach of trust, and register a First Information Report and investigate into the matter to unearth the truth and oblige me for the sake of justice.

This is for your kind information and necessary action.

List of stridhan articles mentioned above are hereinafter mentioned below.

1. One Gold made Necklace and 2 sets of Earrings (Gold made) having approx value of a sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only).
2. Wrist Bangle (Gold made) - 2 pieces approx value of a sum of Rs. 1,20,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Thousand Only).
3. Bangles of Socket (Gold made) - 2 pieces approx value of a sum of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only).
4. Gold made Ring - 1 piece approx value of a sum of Rs. 8,000/- (Rupees Eight Thousand Only).
5. Gold made Chain for my Husband - 1 piece approx value of a sum of Rs. 35,000/- (Rupees Thirty-Five Thousand Only).
6. Gold made Ring for my Husband - 1 piece approx value of a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Thousand Only).
7. One Bed - approx value of a sum of Rs. 1,30,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Thirty Thousand Only).
8. Bed Sets - approx value of a sum of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only).

9. One Cupboard (Almirah) - approx value of a sum of Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand Only).
10. One Dressing Table - Rs. 7,000/- (Rupees Seven Thousand Only).
11. 16 (sixteen) Namaskari
12. 3 (three) sets of Shirt Pitches and Pant Pitches for my Husband.
13. 13 (thirteen) sets of Sarees having approx value of a sum of Rs. 2000/-.
14. Gown for my in-laws daughter having approx value of a sum of Rs. 1500/-.
15. Blazer for my Husband of having approx value of a sum of Rs. 22000/-.
16. 2 sets of Bata Shoes for my Husband having approx value of a sum of Rs. 5000/-
17. Punjabi for my Husband having approx value of a sum of Rs. 1200/-
18. Other than all these things were added 2 sets of shirts, 2 sets of cotton pants and 1 jacket.

Total Stridhan articles approx value is of a sum of Rs. 5,76,700/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Seventy-Six Thousand Seven Hundreds Only).
